IN CITY COUNCIL

September 12, 1977

WHEREAS:

Everett E. Costa, a former employee of the Public Works Department of the City of Cambridge, entered the service of the Public Works Department on May 3, 1960 and was pensioned on February 5, 1977 under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 6 of the General Laws and died on August 8, 1977, having served not less than sixteen years, and

WHEREAS:

At the time of his death said employee had no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor, his widow, Mrs. Mary T. Costa, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law, therefore be it

ORDERED:

That, under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 101 of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by Everett E. Costa, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Mary T. Costa, widow of Everett E. Costa, of \$1,680.00 per year as long as she does not remarry.






