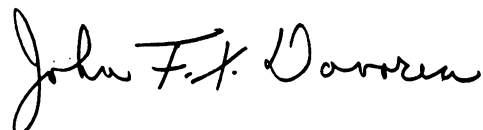

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

I. This Corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for the purpose of promoting public education regarding, and public understanding and appreciation of, dance, music, and other performing arts, with particular emphasis on old English folk dance and music, and, in pursuit of this aim, to sponsor performances, conduct educational programs, support research, and do any and all other appropriate or convenient acts.

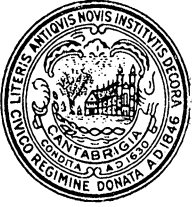

II. In furtherance of the foregoing purposes, but not for any other objects or purposes, and subject to the limitations set forth in Part III hereof, the Corporation shall have and may exercise the following powers:

- (A) To solicit, accept, hold, administer and dispose of money, securities and real and personal property and to take and receive by bequest, devise, gift or benefit of trust any property or interest therein real or personal or mixed, wherever located;
- (B) To make gifts, donations, and contributions of the property, real or personal or mixed, of the Corporation, including but not limited to, money, and to convey, assign, lease, lend or otherwise transfer, with or without consideration, any such property;
- (C) To acquire by purchase, lease, concession, permit, license or in any other manner whatsoever, and to construct, own, hold, maintain, improve, operate, manage, control, sell, convey, mortgage, lease, rent or otherwise dispose of lands, both improved and unimproved, offices, stores and any other structures and real estate of every kind, nature and description, and to acquire by purchase or otherwise, and to own, hold, use, pledge, sell, or otherwise dispose of, and deal in and with, all kinds of personal and real property of every nature and description;
- (D) To invest, reinvest, and administer the funds of the Corporation;
- (E) To borrow money and from time to time make, accept, endorse, execute and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, bonds, debentures and obligations and evidences of indebtedness of all kinds when and as the same may be necessary to or convenient for the accomplishment of the purposes of the Corporation or any of them; and, if deemed advisable, to secure the same by mortgage, deed of trust or pledge, or otherwise, of any or all of the property of the Corporation;
- (F) To erect, construct, reconstruct, repair, remodel, alter, maintain and improve buildings of every de-

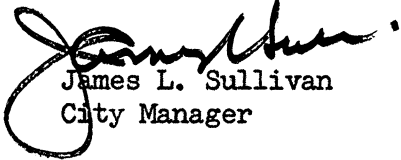
