

City of Cambridge.

In Common Council, April 11 1871

Ordered:- That the Appropriation for Streets and Paving be increased by the further sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars; and that said sum be raised by the creation of a City Debt therefor; and that for said sum Bonds and Notes of the City of Cambridge, or either of them, be issued by the City, on such time, in such sums, at such rate of interest, and bearing such date, as the Committee on Finance shall from time to time direct; and that said Committee on Finance, be and they hereby are authorized to issue and negotiate said Bonds and Notes upon such terms as they shall think for the interest of the City.
