To the Honorable, the City Council,
Gentlemen,

My attention
has been called to the fact that in the Or-
dinance in relation to the Water Works, recently
by adopted, the change in the water-rates is,
by the first section, made to take effect "after
the the thirly-first day of December next";

Owing to a delay in the adoption of said
Ordinance it was not passed to be ordinan-
ced by the two Branches until Dec. 2, 1868,
which would make the change in the water-
rates take effect after the thirly-first day of
December, 1869.

I do not suppose that this was the in-
tention of the City Council, and I would sug-
gest the expediency of repealing the Ordinance

and of re-enacting it with an amendment of
the time when it shall take effect.
