WHEREAS: For several years, residents of the River Street area have expressed strong concern about speeding traffic, especially trucks, on River Street presenting a hazard to school children; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the Cambridge City Council once again requests the City Manager to

- (1) request the police to regularly enforce the speed limit on River Street
- (2) request the Traffic Department to find a way to cover slow down traffic, by for example, timing lights to 25 M.P.H. and so marking and considering an additional light on River Street.
