That the City Manager is hereby requested to consider the advisability of conferring with the Commissioner of the Department of Public Works, Mr. Conrad Fagone, with the thought and view in mind to convince the said Commissioner of the D.P.W. that it is of the utmost importance that care be given to the brick sidewalk in front of the duplex house at 103-105 Otis Street in East Cambridge. It has been reported time and again that the said sidewalk situated in front of 103-105 Otis Street is in disrepair and is constantly causing women who use footwear with very high heels and who pass over the brick sidewalk to attend Masses of various hours in the Saint Hedwig's Church, situated immediately next to the house at 103-105 Otis Street, to be in constant danger of bodily injury. The Councillor from Ward One earnestly prays that the City Manager will give the contents of my order his utmost attention and consideration and report back to this City Council as soon as it is humanly possible.
