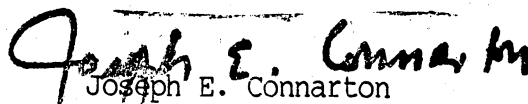
Dear Neighborhood Representative:

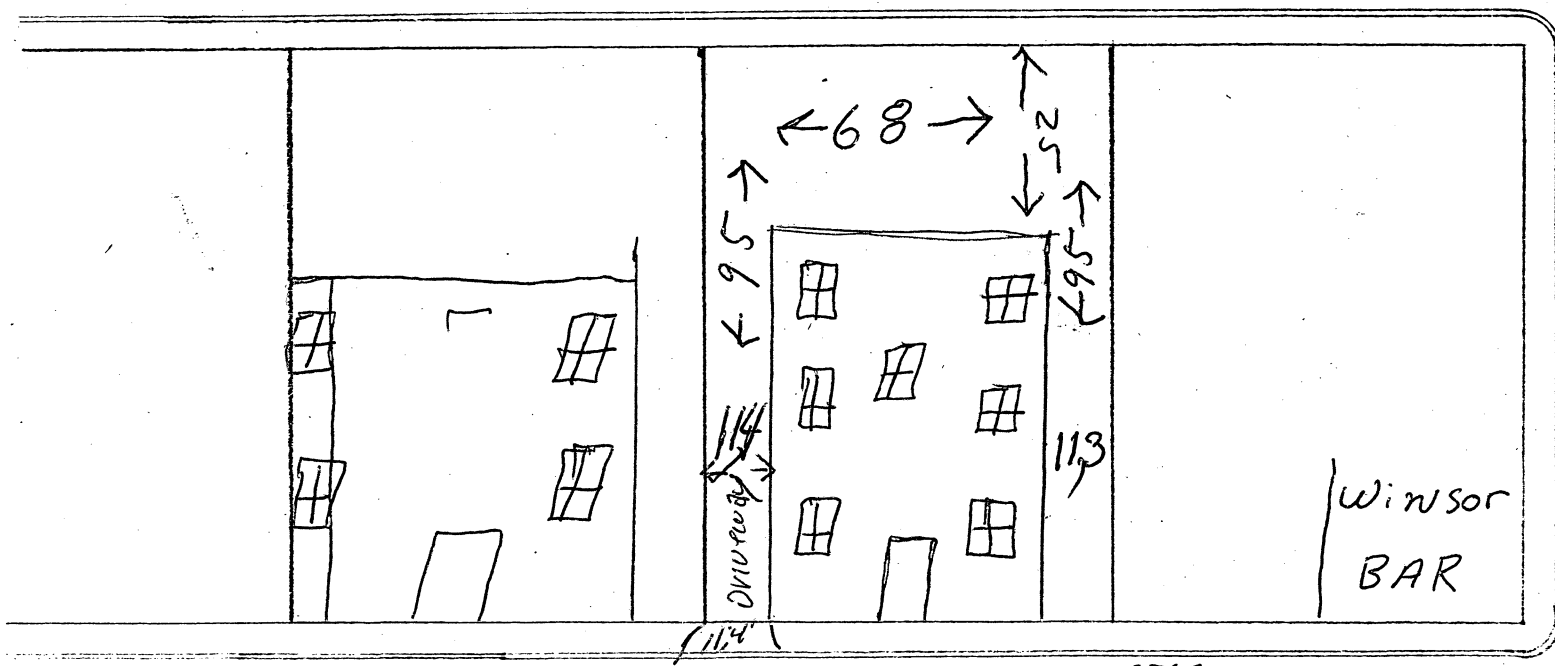

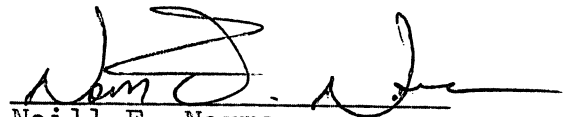
