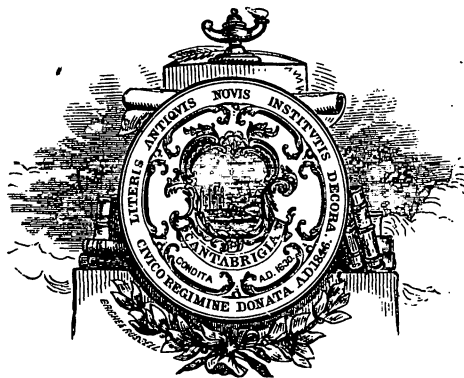


CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.



In Board of Aldermen,

Oct. 5. 1887.

Resolved, That the public convenience and necessity require that *the lines of Vassal Lane* should be established at the *uniform width of forty feet,*

by taking for this purpose certain parcels of land, as shown on a plan prepared by the City Engineer, and now before this Board.

Therefore, Ordered, that so much of the land on *Vassal Lane*, between *Shanks Street*, and *Fayweather Street*,

as is included between the *blue* lines shown on a plan of *said Vassal Lane* ~~Street~~, drawn by the City Engineer, dated *June 9. 1886*, and now before this Board, be taken for public use, and laid out as a public way and a part of said *Vassal Lane* ~~Street~~.

The areas of land taken under this order are recapitulated on the other side of this sheet.

~~Ordered, That damages occasioned by said widening be estimated and awarded as follows:~~

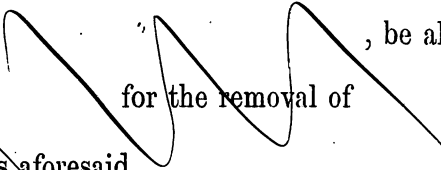
