## Bertha Fritz, 98; lawyer, executive

A funeral will be held today for Bertha Gorin Fritz of Boston, a family business executive who began practicing law in middle age. Mrs. Fritz, who died at her home Saturday, was 98.

Born in Lowell, Mrs. Fritz was raised in Woburn, the eldest child of Nehemias Gorin, the founder of Gorin Stores (later Almy's Stores). She also lived in Newton before moving to Boston in 1968.

A 1946 graduate of Calvin College in Boston, Mrs. Fritz studied for her law degree simultaneously at Portia Law School (now the New England School of Law). Already a grandmother, she passed the Massachusetts bar in 1955 at the age of 53.

She directed Gorin Stores and served as a trustee of the Nechamas Gorin Charitable Foundation. She was a member of Hadasah, Temple Israel of Boston, and New England Hebrew College. Also, she played violin with the Newton Symphony Orchestra.

Mrs. Fritz leaves two daughters, Dorothy Silver of Bedford N.H., and Roberta Goldman of Newton; two sons, Malcolm of Watertown and Richard of Newton; a sister, Ida Leckart of Newton; eight grandchildren; and five great-grandchildren.

The service will be at 1:30 p.m. in Stanetsky Chapels in Brookline. Burial will be in Temple Israel of Boston Cemetery in Wakefield.
