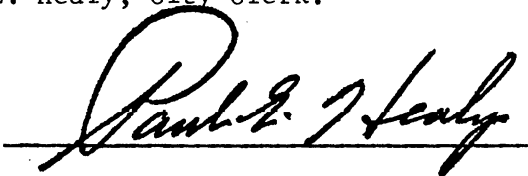
MAYOR RUSSELL
