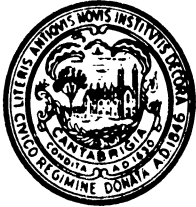

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$728,145.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Service Programs Salary and Wages Account (\$124,130.00), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$603,315.00), and Travel and Training Account (700.00). The Low Income Heating Assistance Program (LIHEAP), serving Cambridge and Somerville, is operated by DHSP and serves 3,000 clients in both cities, 1,400 of which are Cambridge residents. Benefit levels this year will range from \$40 to \$590 per household depending on income and household characteristics. Funding for the program is provided by the Federal government through the Department of Health and Human Services and is administered in Massachusetts by the Commonwealth's Department of Housing and Community Development.
