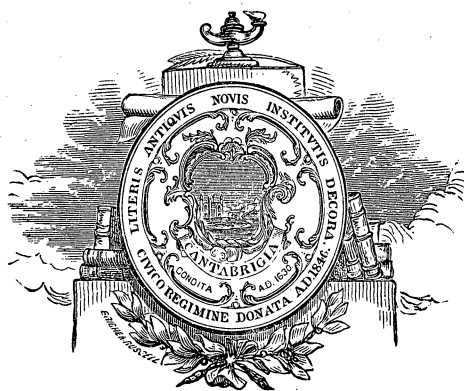




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

Dec 31 1883

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that *Spring Street, so-called* between *Fourth and Ninth Streets,*

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *Fifty feet-* in width between *said Fourth and Ninth* sheet

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *Charles D. Elliot,* Civil Engineer, and dated December 1883

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, *the* owner thereof having waived the usual notice, and agreed to release said land to the city.
