WHEREAS: This year marks the 107th celebration of the Annual Firemen's Ball since, in 1887, Cambridge firemen celebrated the occasion of their first Annual Firemen's Ball; and

WHEREAS: The Cambridge Fire Department is to be commended for its rapid and efficient dispatch to provide safety and relief to the citizens of Cambridge, and for saving the lives of dozens of residents of our City in the past year alone, a service which is of inestimable value; and

WHEREAS: The Cambridge Firemen's Relief Association's tireless volunteer efforts to provide assistance to the families of the firefighters of the City of Cambridge, who themselves provide much needed support to the courageous individuals who risk their lives on behalf of our residents; and

WHEREAS: The history of service and commitment of both the Cambridge Fire Department and the Cambridge Firemen's Relief Association stand as testimony the value of these men and women to our community; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council does hereby congratulate both the Cambridge Firemen's Relief Association and the Cambridge Fire Department on the occasion of the 107th celebration of the Cambridge Firemen's Relief Association Ball; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council, on behalf of all of the residents of the City, does extend its most sincere thanks for the efforts of these two organizations to protect and preserve our City.
