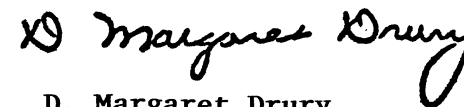

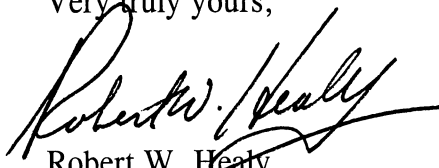

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$697,610 in the Grant Fund of the Human Services Salary & Wages Account (\$119,070), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$577,790), and Travel & Training Account (\$750) to provide funds for the Low Income Heating Assistance Program operating by the Department of Human Services. The program serves 2,000 clients in both Cambridge and Somerville; 900 of which are Cambridge residents. Benefit levels this year will range from \$40 to \$590 per household depending on income and household characteristics. Funding for the program is provided by the Federal government through the Department of Health and Human Services and administered in Massachusetts by the Commonwealth's Department of Housing and Community Development.
