## Report


That upon examination your Committee have found many ordinances upon the same subjects, that there has been many alterations and amendments, repeals and partial repeals, <sup>so</sup> that it will be impossible to make a useful collection without revising, and submitting perhaps some of the Ordinances to the City Council for approval.

That the interest of the City demands, "the revising and digesting the City Ordinances" and that they be arranged in connection with such Statutes as relates to the same subject or gives authority for the passage of such Ordinance, and all Special laws now in force relating to the City.

Also the City Charter and amendments, and such general laws as may be thought proper to insert  
over

with marginal notes and references to judicial decisions,  
and such historical statements as may be necessary and  
proper
