City Council's Right to Lie Rule and the Mayor's Use Thereof on October 16

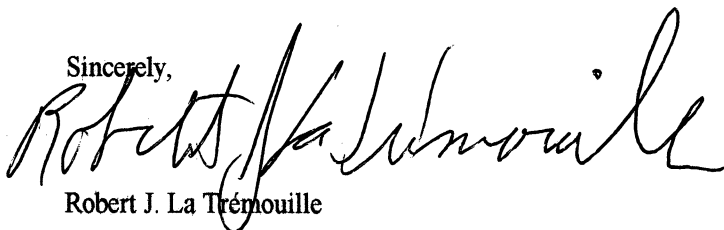
This matter is being raised for the October 30 meeting because I did not learn of the Mayor's outrageous and unfounded attack on me during the October 16 meeting until last Thursday evening when I read the Tuesday Crimson.

I repeat my objection to the City Council's secret vote of May 15 with regard to Quincy Square, both the procedural aspects of the vote and its content, as well as the subsequent proceeding with this development in spite of unanimous objection in the only vote allowed during the belated "review" process. I similarly object to the fake committee on the issue.

On October 16, 1995, I wiped out the Mayor on this issue when we discussed it one-on-one. During the city council meeting when city council rules allow him to lie about the public without the public responding, the mayor simply ignored the beating he had taken and stated that my objections to the secret vote had no basis in fact.

Outrageous and much, much worse.
