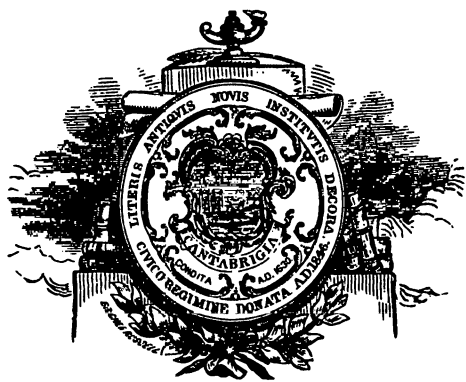

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Faxcroft Street
between Acorn Hill street and Washington
Avenue)

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *40 feet*
in width between *Acorn Hill street and*
Washington Avenue)

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *W.A. Mason* for
Surveyor, and dated Nov. 11. 1882

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, *the*
several owner and owners having agreed in
writing to waive notice of the intention of the city to lay
out said street, and to claim no such damages.

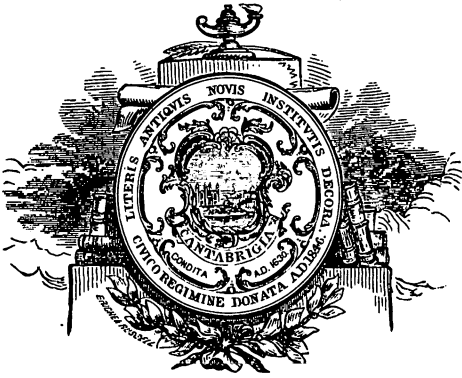
