AN ORDINANCE

In amendment to an Ordinance entitled: "The General Ordinances of the
City of Cambridge"

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:

Chapter 2, entitled: "Administration", Section 153-A List of salaries of members of the Police Department and of the Fire Department, with amendments thereto is hereby further amended by substituting therefor a new section entitled "Section 153-B".

Section 153-B. List of salaries of members of the Police Department.

The members of the Police Department hereafter named shall receive no less than the following salaries, which are annual, and are to be paid monthly or weekly unless otherwise stated. The effective date of Part One shall be January 1, 1973. The effective date of Part Two shall be December 31, 1973.

Service under the provisions of this section relating to the Police Department, as it pertains to permanent officers and permanent policewomen of the department, shall begin with the date of appointment and shall continue until his death, retirement, or discharge.

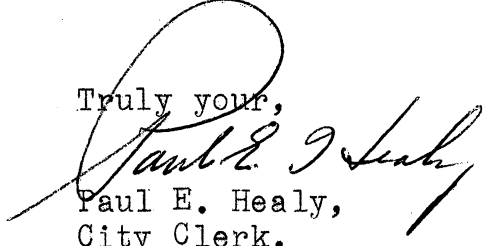
