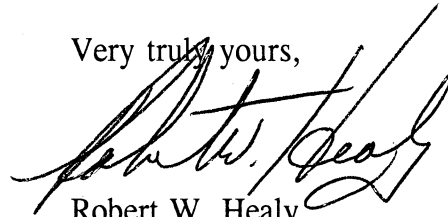

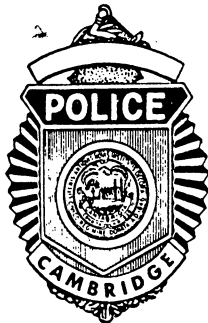

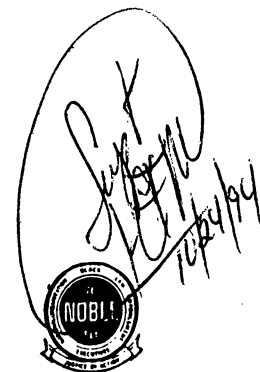
The following action plan is being recommended, pending your approval, for heavy trucking violations along Fresh Pond Parkway.

- State Police Brighton have been contacted and advised of the concerns of the neighborhood and Troopers assigned to patrol Fresh Pond Parkway will target truckers illegally using the roadway.
- State Police Commercial Enforcement team has been advised of the concerns of the neighbors, as well as that of the City of Cambridge, and the truck team will target the area of Fresh Pond Parkway. The first enforcement action began today along the parkway and the team will return on a random basis to the City of Cambridge to assist the Cambridge Police Department with truck enforcement there as well as throughout the entire city.
- Cambridge Police officers assigned to the area have been advised that while on patrol if any violations are noted along the roadway they are to act upon the violations.
- Cambridge Police officers are being scheduled to attend the State Police commercial truck enforcement school, a two week course that will allow the Cambridge Police to enforce all commercial truck enforcement except weighing of trucks.
- An education effort within the Cambridge Police Department will take place and all sworn personnel will be issued a list of truck bans within Cambridge.
