The use of a bicycle as a means of transportation around Cambridge is popular, efficient and sensible, but often hazardous; and

WHEREAS:

Safe bicycling is to be encouraged; therefore, be it

ORDERED:

That the City Manager is hereby requested to oversee a comprehensive program for a "Safe Bicycling Month" in April and further that this program include:

1. Education of children and adults, bicyclists, drivers, and pedestrians;
2. A campaign of enforcement of laws and regulations relating to bicyclists and to drivers as they impact bicyclists;
3. A review of existing bicycle routes and paths with the objective of increasing opportunities available for the safe use of the bicycles as a means of transportation; and
4. Publicity of these activities to make the public aware of bicycle safety issues and "Safe Bicycling Month";

and, be it further

ORDERED:

That the City Manager report to the City Council the plan for this campaign.
