ORDERED:

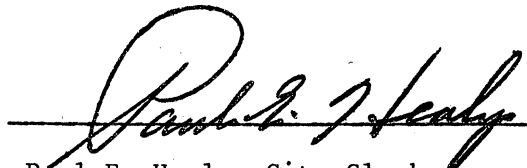

Provided that, before erecting the above named awning, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Inspectional Services Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Three Thousand (\$3,000.) Dollars conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said awning.

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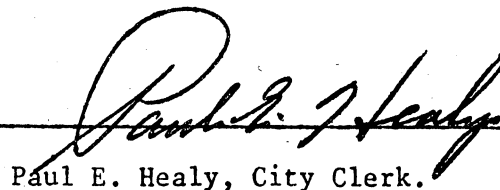
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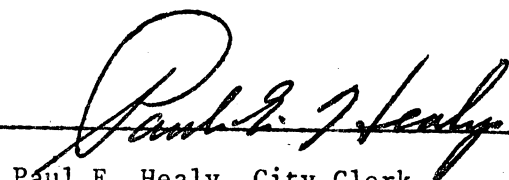

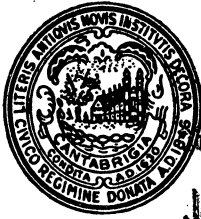
