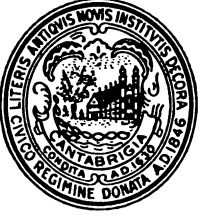

I have been in the process of setting up the Resident Sticker Program in the Riverside Area and East Cambridge Area of the City and also expanding the program in the Brattle Street Area.

In order to put this program into operation by January 1, 1974, I will need extra money in my budget for permits, stickers, information cards, visitor permits, files, signs and postage.

I, therefore request that the sum of \$8,000.00 be transferred from the Parking Fund to the following Traffic and Parking Department accounts:


