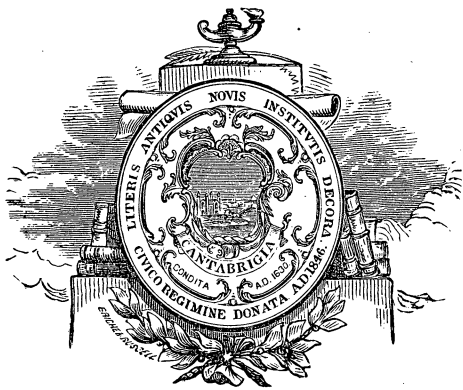

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *the City Engineer,* dated *July 25. 1884,*

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, *the several owners and abutters having signed a release of the same.*

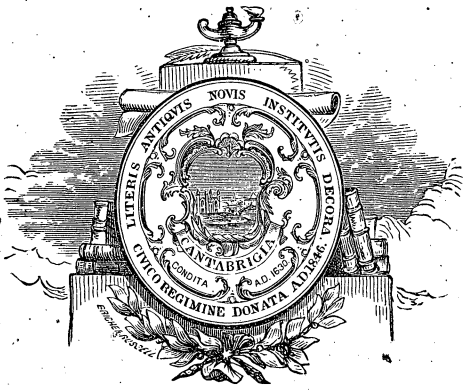

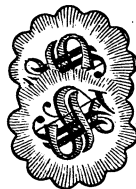

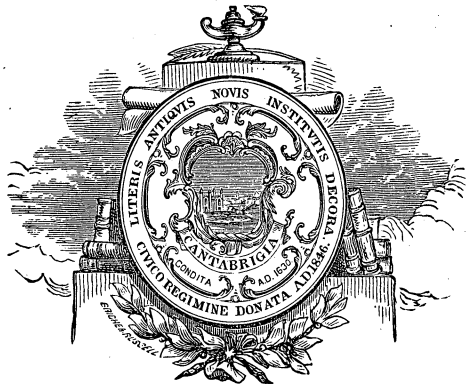
