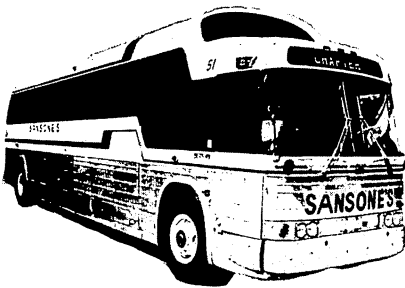

<u>IN CAMBRIDGE:</u> Pick up and discharge points; Kresge Auditorium, Harvard Square Service to be provided, Friday, Saturday, Sunday	On Interchange 18 between Recreation Road (entrance to Massachusetts Turnpike) and River Street On River Street between Interchange 18 and Massachusetts Avenue On Massachusetts Avenue between River Street and Amherst Street On Amherst Street between Darmouth Street and Massachusetts Avenue On Massachusetts Avenue between Amherst Street and Harvard Square Through Harvard Square On Massachusetts Avenue between Harvard Square and Western Avenue On Western Avenue between Massachusetts Avenue and Interchange 18 On Massachusetts Avenue between Amherst Street and Harvard Bridge (Boston City Line) Return over same route.
