IN CITY COUNCIL

November 25, 1974

ORDERED:

That, in accordance with the provisions of the General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge now known and designated as "The Code of the City of Cambridge" that in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 3, Sections 3-1 through 3-7, inclusive, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to the Young Men's Christian Association of 820 Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge for the installation and maintenance of a banner across the public way known as Massachusetts Avenue for a period of sixty days.

This permit is granted subject to the following conditions:

1. That the sign from pole to pole does not extend more than fifty feet and with dimensions of thirty feet long and three feet wide and to be seventeen feet above the sidewalk grade and to be maintained in such a position that it does not interfere with the flow of heavy vehicles.
2. This permit is granted subject to the approval of the Director of Traffic and Parking as to location and in his discretion he may require any changes in the placement of the banner as warranted by the traffic condition.
3. The petitioner shall file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said banner.
