- WHEREAS: There is concern among those who live and work in Cambridge about the environmental health and livability of the city, particularly in relation to air quality, climate protection, and traffic congestion; and
- WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge is working to implement programs that deal with these problems; and
- WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge is working to encourage use of alternative modes of transportation (walking, cycling, ridesharing, public transit) and is working to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, including forming a Climate Protection Task Force; and
- WHEREAS: It is important for the City of Cambridge to publicize and promote environmental awareness and action; and
- WHEREAS: The City has organized a number of events to promote environmental awareness and action, including the Cambridge Earth Day EcoTour (May 13), Commute a Better Way Day (May 17), and a series of Bicycle Safety Rodeos (Saturdays in May); and
- WHEREAS: Private groups have organized a number of complementary events, including the Cambridge Center for Adult Education Climate Protection Conference (May 19) and a variety of Arbor Day celebrations and nature walks; and

- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council hereby proclaims May 2000 as **GOGREEN MONTH**, and encourages everyone who lives and works in Cambridge to participate in these events and integrate environmental awareness and action into their daily activities.
