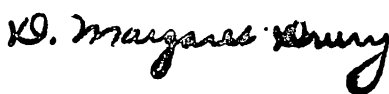

WHEREAS: Lawrence was appointed to the Fire Department on May 25, 1965 where he was assigned to Ladder Company Number Three and was reassigned to Engine Company Three on January 16, 1966; and

WHEREAS: Lawrence held numerous assignments, such as:
Rescue Company Number One-March 15, 1967;
Engine Company Number Four- January 27, 1974;
Rescue Company Number One-February 12, 1978;
Engine Company Number Four- July 2, 1978; and to
Fire Prevention-September 16, 1984; and

WHEREAS: Lawrence was promoted to Lieutenant on January 27, 1974 and to Captain on May 9, 1982; and

WHEREAS: Lawrence served as the Local Emergency Planning Committee Coordinator; and

WHEREAS: Lawrence was the recipient of the Massachusetts Emergency Management Award in 2001; the Massachusetts Firefighter of the Year Award for Community Service, the State Emergency Response Agency Award and the Associated Press Award; and

WHEREAS: Lawrence was instrumental in instituting fire prevention programs in the schools; he created a fire safety television series for kids, established a high-rise safety seminar for hotels in Cambridge, the Toys for Tots Program in the Fire Department, the Fire Department Medal Day, and wrote the grant for the Student Awareness Fire Education Program for Cambridge Schools; and

WHEREAS: Lawrence received the Distinguished Fire Department Service Award and the Employee of the Year for 2002; now therefore be it
