ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the Recreation Director with the view in mind of replacing the plaque at said playground; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a rededication ceremony upon completion of the installation of the plaque.
