Numerous complaints have been received from area residents relative to the towing practices and facilities currently in effect within our city; and

WHEREAS:

Many residents, upon claiming their vehicles, after being towed, have noticed that said vehicles have been damaged in the process of being towed; and

WHEREAS:

The City of Cambridge realizes some \$350,000.00 annually from the tagging of these cars prior to there being towed; therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to immediately confer with the Chief of Police and the Director of Traffic and Parking in order that a towing service under the jurisdiction of the Police Department such as the one Boston Police operate may be implemented as soon as possible in order to correct the conditions stated in this resolution.
