RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record expressing its appreciation to the Cambridge firefighters and paramedics at Cambridge Fire Headquarters, whose quick and skilled response resulted in the healthy birth and triage of baby Samuel; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Cambridge firefighters and paramedics on behalf of the entire City Council.
