WHEREAS: All streets and roads in Cambridge should serve the transportation needs of its residents; and

WHEREAS: Those streets and roads that are in need of repair often impede safe use, and also damage the physical appearance of the city; and

WHEREAS: Residents on Field Street have repeatedly sought the repair of the surface of Field Street and the surface of its sidewalk; and

WHEREAS: No apparent action had been taken to see to its repair; and

WHEREAS: The continued poor condition of Field Street and sidewalk poses a daily problem for residents in the neighborhood; therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager, through the Department of Public Works, replace or fix the surface of Field Street and its sidewalk, and report back in two weeks as to the progress of the repair.

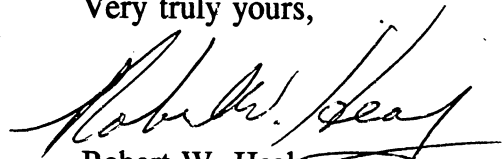
