WHEREAS: Chester E. Hallice was born in Cambridge on January 7, 1907 and was educated in the Cambridge School System prior to his appointment to the Cambridge Police Department on June 13, 1936, and was promoted to Sergeant in November of 1945 and achieved the rank of Captain in January of 1966 and served with distinction until his retirement in 1974, having received several commendations during his career for his outstanding performance of duty; and

WHEREAS: Chester E. Hallice was a graduate of F.B.I. National Police Academy and served as National President of that association and also was honored by being elected President of the Cambridge Police Mutual Aid Association and rendered outstanding service as officer in charge of the Police Academy from 1956 to 1966; and

WHEREAS: Chester E. Hallice was an outstanding family man and the father of six children, Chester, a retired State Police Officer, John, a Sub-Master at the Haggerty School, James, a sergeant in the Cambridge Police Department, Francis, a teacher at the Martin Luther King School and daughters Mary Lou Scott and Jane Melia and is the proud grandparent of eighteen grandchildren; therefore be it
