- RESOLVED: That this City Council do hereby proclaim the week of May 20 through May 24, 1985 as:

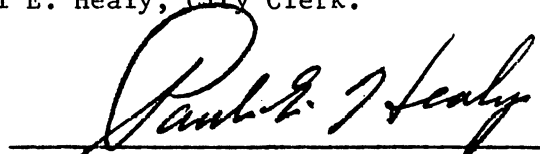
"HEAD START WEEK"
