In the year one thousand eight hundred

An Ordinance  
prescribing the mode of appointing  
certain city officers -

Be it ordained by the City Council  
of the City of Cambridge as follows -

The mayor and alderman of the said  
city [he and <sup>are hereby</sup> they ~~herely~~ are] authorized  
to appoint for the current and  
every succeeding municipal year  
the following city officers - to wit  
Field Drivers - Fence receivers - Health  
Officers - Fish Officers, Sealer of Weights  
and measures Surveyors of Lumber  
Measurers of Wood and Bark Hay Weigh-  
ers, Sealers of Leathers and Coal Baskets  
and Pound Keepers.
