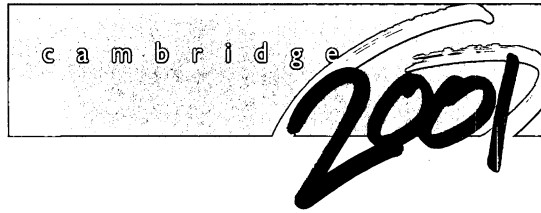

To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of a grant from the Massachusetts Department of Housing and Community Development for \$423,655 to the Grant Fund Human Services Salaries and Wages account (\$8,566) and Other Ordinary Maintenance account (\$415,089), to provide additional funds for the Low Income Heating Assistance Program to cover the high cost of heating oil this past winter as well as a slight increase in the number of people applying for benefits. In addition, the Salaries and Wages account will support staffing to assist in administering the program.
