Henry H. Desmarais, a former employee of the Cambridge Housing Authority of the City of Cambridge, entered the service of the Cambridge Housing Authority on April 2, 1957 and was pensioned on June 6, 1969 under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 7 of the General Laws and died on July 10, 1973, having served not less than twelve years, and

WHEREAS:

At the time of his death said employee had no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor, his widow, Mrs. Ida B. Desmarais, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law, therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That, under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 101 of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good, and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by Henry H. Desmarais, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Ida B. Desmarais, of \$1,680.00 per year as long as she does not remarry.
