That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Edward D'Amato, Business Manager of the Cambridge Family YMCA for the erection of a banner across Massachusetts Avenue from 820 Massachusetts Avenue to 831 Massachusetts Avenue, commencing on May 1, 1983 through December 31, 1983.

Provided that, before erecting the above named banner, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said banner.
