WHEREAS: Construction on the Truss Bridge at Alewife is moving along rapidly; and

WHEREAS: Serious concerns for pedestrian safety have been expressed by the North Cambridge Community; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City of Cambridge Traffic and Parking Department confer with the State Highway Department, or the State Police, to address the concerns of Pedestrian safety at Rindge Avenue opposite the parkway from the MBTA station, especially the timing of the pedestrian light at the corner of Rindge Ave and Fresh Pond Parkway, which at present has a walk time which is much too short for the average pedestrian to walk across in safety.
