PEARL STREET - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Massachusetts Avenue
Thence southerly on Pearl Street
0.77 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at the junction of
Granite Street;
the total distance being 0.77 miles.

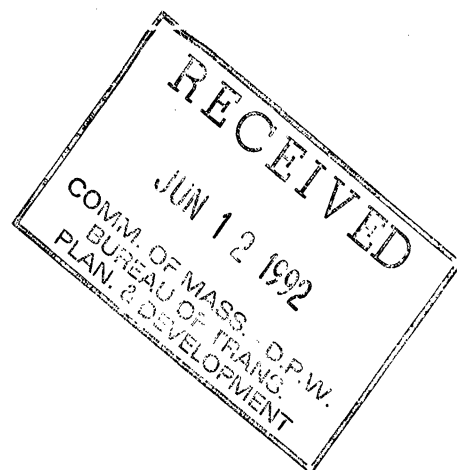

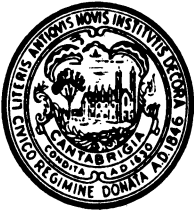

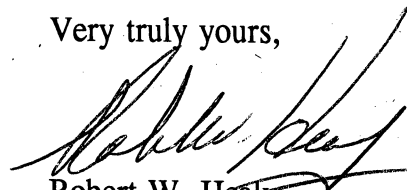
