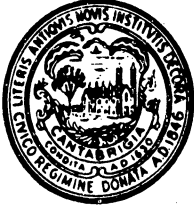

To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 10, regarding a report on enforcing the ordinance relative to clearing sidewalks of snow and ice following storms, Public Works Commissioner Ralph Dunphy reports the following:

The Public Works Department employs three full time inspectors. To date this winter season, inspectors have issued 381 warning violations and 7 \$25.00 tickets. Tickets are issued to residents who have already received one warning violation.

The Public Works Snow Clearing Hotline has helped Inspectors enforce the Sidewalk Clearing Ordinance. All addresses left on the hotline are inspected on a daily basis.

In addition to the addresses received on the hotline, the Inspectors enforce other ordinances which allows them access to many City streets and sidewalks daily.
