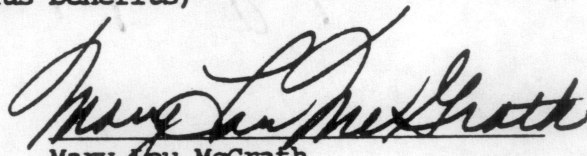
Position: Parent Liaison, Morse School

Duties: The Parent Liaison is responsible to the school Principal and the Citywide Parent Coordinator. The Parent Liaison will assist in organizing, recruitment and providing support to school organizations and committees that require parent involvement; provide and coordinate activities that will encourage parent involvement in the school; attendance and participation in staff meetings, individual supervisory sessions, workshops and training sessions as planned by the Citywide Parent Coordinator; work cooperatively with the school administration and staff; assist in the recruitment and registration of parents; explain desegregation policies and procedures to parents; coordinate and implement school tour/class visits policy for incoming parents; act as a conduit of information between parents and school; coordinate individual parent/teacher conferences, as requested; require attendance at Student Support Team, School Improvement Council and PTO; require flexible work schedule to accommodate early morning parents, coffee nights, and after school meetings and occasional Saturday Parent activities.

Minimum Requirements:

Demonstrated work and/or life experiences in the following areas: organizing abilities; leadership abilities; writing skills, familiarity with Cambridge School System; understanding and sensitivity to diverse urban city populations; interpersonal skills; parent of a child enrolled in the Morse School; preference will be given to a person who has demonstrated a deep interest in the Morse School.
