The inspections will take place July 16-18, 1980. If you have any questions please contact me.

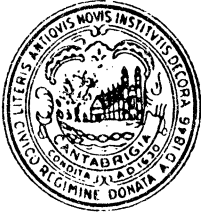

During the week of July 14, 1980 the Cambridge Health Department will be conducting a rodent survey of your street and the surrounding neighborhood. This survey will consist of the inspection of sources of rodent food, rodent harborage, active rat signs, and potential rodent entries.

Any condition found in violation of the State Sanitary Code will be reported to the owner with an order to correct that violation.

If you see a person on your property conducting an inspection, please ask for identification for your own protection.

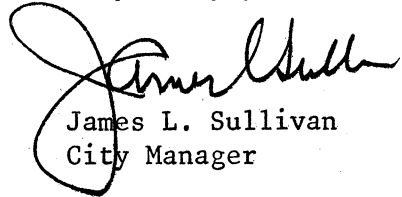
