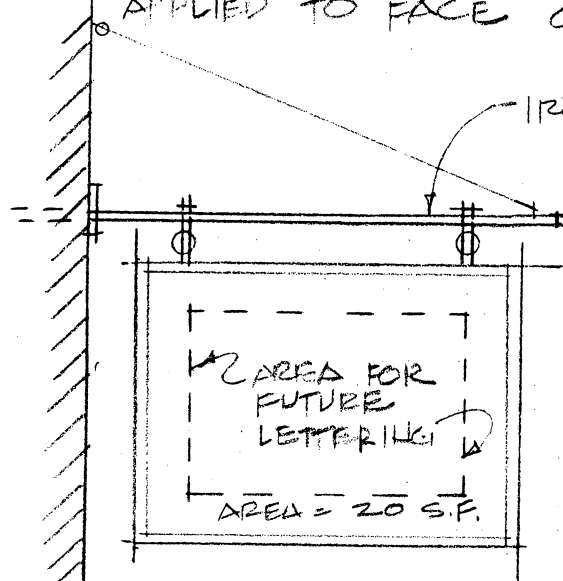

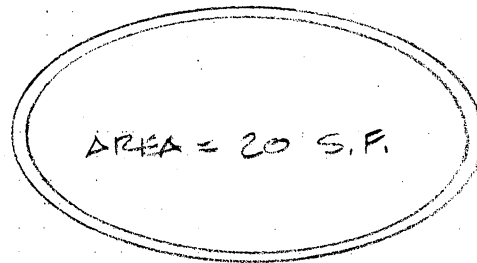
SIGN PANELS ARE TO BE HUNG FROM GALVANIZED IRON PIPE PROJECTING FROM BRICK WALL.

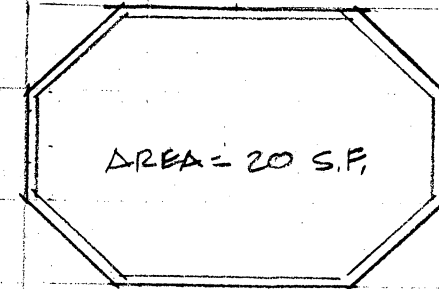
