Madam Mayor, a term I used at our last meeting I believe, was incorrect I said I had sovereignty. What should have been indicated is that I have the Sovereignty of Constitutional Authority, but if you or any council member can prove that I do not, I'd be delighted to pursue other avenues otherwise if you can't then this matter is real and it's time for the council to act because the council's oath of office centers around one subject, defense of the Constitution of the United States and that oath does not permit evasion of duty. I now complete the first National Officer's Report in an orderly manner with two additions.

I hereby declare that all UN military authority in the United States is invalid and all such commanders on our powerful and mighty land must obey United States Military Orders.

Secondly I'm ordering all State National Guard Units and citizens who wish to work with them to search for military bases containing or run by foreign military forces on US soil. Especially in isolated places or underground bases. You are also to locate and remove suspicious stockpiles of weapons in buildings or being transported in large anonymous or disguised trucks traveling to isolated areas.

You are to inform the commanders of such bases that they are to leave the United States. There are no wars in North America and there are plenty of areas in other friendly lands where there are conflicts for training to occur.

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Are The Problems of American Government Due To A Now-Inadequate U.S. Constitution? *If So, Should The Constitution Be Rewritten?*

(An Introductory Note by Free Press Editor Art Kunkin:

Until I read the article below, first published as an editorial in the March 1996 issue of Harper's Magazine, I believed that only very reactionary right-wing conservatives interested in nullifying the Bill of Rights and imposing a totalitarian government on the American people proposed rewriting the U.S. Constitution. Along with most other Americans, I consider the Constitution as amended by the Bill of Rights to be a very important guarantee of political and social democracy. So when a very large number of State Legislatures in the middle 1960's passed resolutions calling for a Constitutional Convention to rewrite the U.S. Constitution so that it would include a balanced budget provision they wanted, I wrote a Los Angeles Free Press editorial against that proposal. I based my argument on the opinion of constitutional experts who said that there was a real danger that a Constitutional Convention called to change government on one issue would have, or could assume, the legal authority to replace the existing Constitution with a far more undemocratic document.

Then I read the article we publish below and changed my mind somewhat. I began to appreciate that however valuable the present Constitution is as a general mission statement for freedom and individual rights, the detailed description in the Constitution of the much applauded system of checks and balances between the executive, the legislative branches and the judiciary may be ultimately responsible for the paralysis of American government and the corruption which angers the American people today.

In other words, it may be possible that the present day distrust of government by the majority of Americans has at its roots, at least in part, a Constitution which was originally written by an elite group of rich white men who feared democratic government (hence no voting rights originally for non-property owners, for women or for black slaves, and no Bill of Rights until it was forced upon them through the first ten amendments) and who even established an undemocratic Electoral College that threatens to invalidate the popular vote in every presidential election and who, furthermore and perhaps most important, deliberately divided the national government into an executive office, two legislative bodies and a judiciary to create a very weak national government that would allow a hidden economic elite to be the real rulers.

Posing these issues as questions, do we need to rewrite and replace our 200 year old Constitution with a more modern mission statement and procedures to ensure a better functioning and more responsive government? With every major corporation in the United States finding it necessary to reformulate their mission statements and procedures as the new century approaches, with almost every other government in the world functioning with constitutions that were newly formulated after World War Two, can we in the United States solve our twenty-first-century problems with an eighteenth-century Constitution based on seventeenth-century principles?

✱ But if a new Constitution may prove to be an essential part of the solution to our present problems, we obviously will have to be very careful to avoid throwing out the baby when disposing of the dirty bath water! The present Constitution is widely and properly accepted as a historic mission statement for freedom and individualism. If this Constitution is found wanting, it must not be replaced by a document that will establish a dictatorship of any kind. Therefore, the American people must have as much time as possible, and we believe starting immediately, to discuss the good and possibly bad aspects of the present

U.S. Constitution before any decisions are made about a new Constitution. In the spirit of these very fundamental questions, we provide for our readers the full text of the Harper's Magazine editorial. And to continue our participation in this very important discussion, we plan to further review and possibly reprint excerpts from the very important book by Daniel Lazare which is cited by Mr Lapham at the beginning of his editorial. Old-time religion

What we wanted, we did not know; what we knew, we did not want.

During a presidential election year I expect the books published on political themes to read like the speeches at a Fourth of July picnic--heartwarming cant as plentiful as the beer and as empty as the balloons--but six weeks before the New Hampshire primaries I discovered "The Frozen Republic: How The Constitution Is Paralyzing Democracy," by Daniel Lazare to be the exception that proves the rule.

In the sanctuary of the American civil religion nothing except a private fortune in excess of \$5 Billion is more precious than the four pages of parchment brought forth by the corporate sponsors of liberty in Philadelphia in the summer of 1787. Lazare, an accomplished iconoclast, manages within the space of a few hundred pages to assign them to the realm of magical objects in which a museum of natural history also might place the totem poles, the scraps of sacred moleskin, and the bones of a departed saint. I'm not enough of a constitutional scholar to find the flaws in Lazare's legal reasoning, but his knowledge of American history is as persuasive as his wit and, despite his lack of academic connections and provenience in the often ideological left (as a columnist for The Village Voice and the New York editor of In These Times, I was glad to encounter a writer willing to suggest that only by reconfiguring our system of government (i.e. by rewriting the Constitution) can we address what by now have become the all too obvious consequence of our political weaknesses and stupidity.

The proposition seems to me to stand as proven in any morning's newspaper. At least one story in every four speaks to the presence of a constitutional crisis that we pretend not to notice but which accurately defines the enfeebled state of our national politics--the federal government twice shut down in the early winter because of a quarrel about a balanced budget (i.e., a metaphysical dispute about a set of wholly imaginery numbers), the futility of a Congress unable to negotiate a disarmament treaty with a citizenry possessed of 200 million guns, the selling off of the public lands despite the objections of at least 60% of the nominally sovereign American people, the notion of legitimate political authority so far from anybody's mind that the office of the presidency can be bought at a price well below that of a second-rate company or a losing football team.

Lazare arranges his polemic in historical sequence--the origins of the Constitution as a marvel of eighteenth-century political mechanics made to the design of seventeenth-century religious belief, the

impious (and unanswerable) questions forced on its infallible authority by the Civil War, the desperate denials of the document's obvious imperfections during the era of American ascendance following the victories in the Second World War, the blind worship of the sacred text that has accompanied the last fifty years of the country's descent into bankruptcy and the wisdom of Rush Limbaugh.

Three of Lazare's points about the obsolete and the undemocratic character of the Constitution strike me as useful glosses on a presidential campaign likely to present the owner of Forbes Magazine as the friend of the common man.

1. Virtuous Incapacity

Listening to a politician talk, or while reading an indignant editorial in an earnest newspaper, the trusting citizen might make the mistake of thinking that the government was supposed to work--as if political power were a form of energy (like diesel fuel or department store credit) meant to be used for a constructive purpose. The supposition is false, but it gives rise to the chorus of complaint (about crime and drugs and federal fraud, or the cities falling into ruins and the suburbs foundering in the morass of debt, or the failures of will and the lack of an ennobling moral vision) that accompanies the ritual of an American election. The complaints goad the candidates to promises of reform, which supply the news media with headlines, but have nothing to do with anything other than their own reflection in the public opinion polls.

The government was never supposed to work, at least not in the ways imagined by a municipal planning commission. The political shambles is deliberate, and the government's incompetence a testimony to its virtue. The gentlemen who wrote the Constitution were as suspicious of efficient government as they were wary of democracy, a "turbulence and a folly" that they associated with the unruly ignorance of an urban mob. They looked upon political power as a corrupting influence--in much the same way that William Bennett and Pat Buchanan look upon the evil of crack cocaine--and they belonged by temperament to what in seventeenth-century England would have been understood as "The Country Party"--well-to-do gentry, many of them Puritans, who opposed, on principle as well as for reasons of interest, what was known as "The Court Party." Lazare cites Lawrence Stone's *The Causes of the English Revolution* on the division between the two parties, a division that continues to define, much to our misfortune and nearly 350 years after Charles I lost his head, the ideal and anti-ideal of the American political dream:

"The Country was peaceful and clean, a place of grass and trees and birds, the city (on the other hand) was ugly and dirty and noisy, a place of clattering cars and coaches, coal dust and smog, and piles of human excrement....the Country was virtuous, the Court wicked; the Country was thrifty, the Court extravagant; the Country was honest, the Court corrupt; the Country was chaste and heterosexual, the Court promiscuous and homosexual; the Country was sober, the Court drunken...the Country was outspoken, the Court sycophantic; the Country was the defender of the old ways and old liberties, the Court the promoter of administrative novelties and new tyrannical practices..."

Like their descendants on both our own Arcadian left and Suburban right, the wealthy American planters and merchants who wrote the Constitution associated themselves with the purity of the Country Party. Believing themselves morally and intellectually superior to the democratic rabble, they defined the practice of government as the duty of the judicious few to control and improve the instincts of the foolish many, and they undertook to render the federal political power as impotent as a eunuch in the court of a Ming emperor. Power was to be kept out of the hands of children (also known as the sovereign people) and anybody as likely as Alexander Hamilton to make of government an efficient instrument of intelligible purpose.

Hamilton was a forward-looking man who assumed that the events looming below the horizon of the future would best be met by a strong government and a flexible constitution. Jefferson imagined that America in 1900 would look much the way it looked in 1800 and, with more or less the same pastoral prospect in mind, the editorial committee in Philadelphia conceived the portrait of the American future as a romantic reconstruction of the Roman or Tudor past. Toward that idyllic end they produced a government weak enough to preserve the institution of slavery and a Constitution rigid enough to resist the invasions of social change. The Preamble granted unlimited powers to "We the People," but Article V (the clause that make amendment virtually impossible by requiring a two-thirds vote in both houses of Congress and ratification by three-fourths of the states) declared the Preamble null and void. Denied the means of revising what suddenly had become an immutable and ancient law, the newly independent Americans enjoyed even less freedom to alter the course of their destiny than the subjects of George III.

2. *Balanced Impotence*

By containing the powers of government in a mechanism as finely balanced as a late seventeenth-century ornamental clock, the authors of the Constitution distributed political energy among so many weights and counterweights that nobody could say for certain how the movement originated or where sovereignty was to be found. Let the several functions of government work at cross purposes (the legislature against the executive, the executive against the legislature, and the judiciary against anyone it chose) and with any luck they would hold one another indefinitely at bay. Political power divided into as many parts as the fragments of the True Cross couldn't interfere with the economic power, and the marvelous state of suspended animation served everybody's interests as long as everyone agreed that the private good was another name for the public good. But the practice of keeping slaves presented the gentlemen in Philadelphia with a contradiction for which their Constitution had no answer (human liberty on the one hand, and private property on the other), and the absence of a political means of addressing the question resulted, seventy-four years later, in the Civil War and more than 600,000 dead.

Contrary to Lord Acton's often quoted dictum about the corruption inherent in absolute power (i.e., the "tyrannous and arbitrary power" dreaded by the eighteenth-century American gentry and reviled by the teachers of twentieth-century American civics lessons), concentrated power can be plainly seen and (if the opposition has the courage to do so) held to account. Power broken into a thousand pieces can be hidden and disowned. If no individual or institution possesses the authority to act without the consent of everybody else in the room, then nobody is ever at fault if anything goes wrong. Congress can blame the President, the President can blame the Congress or the Supreme Court, the Supreme Court can blame the Mexicans or the weather in Ohio.

Checked and balanced by powers of all denominations, the country's public servants become, in theory, accountable to everybody; in practice they remain accountable to nobody, "dithering and indecisive, borne aloft on great billows of empty rhetoric," free to strike attractive moral attitudes while at the same time selling their votes to the highest corporate bidder. By further complicating the proceedings with congressional committees and subcommittees (now numbering nearly 300) and a myriad of federal, state, regulatory, regional, and district government entities blessed with the authority to levy and collect taxes (at last count numbering at least 83,000 in the United States), the machinery of divided government disperses even the semblance of responsibility into a haze of impotent recrimination.

3. *The God in the Machine*

Lazare traces the fervor of our present constitutional devotions to the complacency that settled on the American mind in the years immediately following the Second World War, and he begins his chapter on

the consequences of that complacency with the observation that "the only thing more dangerous than total defeat is total victory." The winning of the war prompted Americans to think that their military and industrial supremacy was proof of their moral and political virtue and, by 1953, Daniel Boorstin, the historian soon to become the Librarian of Congress, was attributing what he called "the genius of American politics" to Divine Providence:

"...It is not surprising that we have no enthusiasm for plans to make society over. We have actually made a new society without a plan. Or, more precisely, why should we make a five-year plan for ourselves when God seems to have had a thousand-year plan ready for us."

Almost everybody else in the country at the time, Democrat and Republican as well as liberal and conservative held to similar beliefs--God was in his heaven, all was right in the world, America was great because it was America, and the Constitution had been brought to Washington in a glass box by the Archangel Gabriel. The less fortunate nations of the earth might have to suffer the indignity of realigning their political thought with the events of the second half of the twentieth century--in the last fifty years, new constitutions have appeared in Germany, France, Portugal, Holland, Sweden, Denmark, Russia and Japan--but the Americans, being American and therefore perfect, could afford to look upon the stately passing of recorded time with the serene indifference of Mt. Rushmore. What was the point of thinking seriously about politics when the country was being governed, as it had always been governed, by the magic parchment in the museum with George Washington's inkwell and Benjamin Franklin's wig?

The United States, in the meantime, fell behind every other country in the industrialized world in most of the categories that measure the well-being of a civilized society--the most brutal police force and the most crowded prisons, the harshest system of criminal justice, repressive drug laws, a lazy and sycophantic press. Over the span of the same fifty years, our political campaigns have come to resemble nothing so much as games of trivial pursuit, charades reduced to works of performance art in which the candidates smear one another with insults instead of chocolate.

All observations about the country falling off its marble pedestal were met by referrals to the Constitution. America was still the wonder of the world because our wealth made us wise, and because in its handsome display case in Washington, as miraculous as the engines aboard the Starship "*Enterprise*," the Constitution was protecting, by day as by night, the liberties of its chosen people. The assumption renders any further effort at political thought both unnecessary and impious.

Theocratic societies tend to have a weak grasp of reality, and toward the end of his book, remarking on the fulminations of the Country Party presently holding the majority in Congress, Lazare says, "All those Republican House freshmen in early 1995 who could be seen sporting copies of the Federalist Papers were not all that different from Iranian mullahs waving copies of the Koran." An historian rather than a political scientist or a first-year congressman, Lazare doesn't offer a set of instructions for redrafting the Constitution, but he carries his point about our idolatrous worship of the document, depriving us of the courage to imagine a future that doesn't look like one of the Disney Company's replicas of the nonexistent American past. The framers of the Constitution lived in a world innocent of electricity, jet airplanes, telephones, computers, nuclear weapons, and MTV; if their political mechanism had already become outworn by the middle of the nineteenth-century (i.e., incapable of resolving the question of slavery), then how can we expect it to address the questions likely to be presented by the twenty-first century?

The following pages of this book fill in more details of who the beast new world order is.

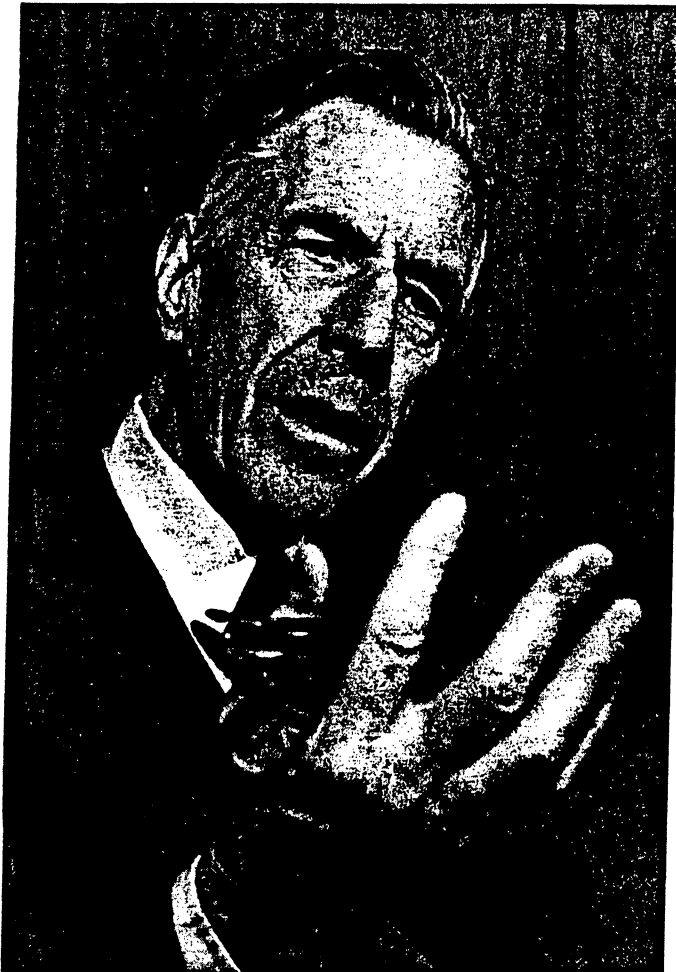

Some of his previous, better-known works include *The Discovery of Noah's Ark*, *Moles in High Places*, *The Open Gates of Troy*, *No Place to Hide*, *World without Cancer*, *The Capitalist Conspiracy*, *More Deadly than War*, *The Grand Design*, *The Great Prison Break*, and *The Fearful Master*.

Mr. Griffin is a graduate of the University of Michigan where he majored in Speech and Communications. In preparation for writing this book, he enrolled in the College of Financial Planning located in Denver. His goal was not to become a professional financial planner but to better understand the real world of investments and money markets. John Kenneth Galbraith, well-known historian and professor at Harvard, has verified that he was asked to be a part of the team that put together *The Report from Iron Mountain*, a think-tank study commissioned by the Defense Department. The purpose of the study was to explore novel ways of keeping the masses in subservience. When a copy of the *Report* was leaked to the press, the government claimed it was a hoax. Galbraith confirmed that it was totally authentic.

THE SECRET SOCIETY

Lord Alfred Milner was a key figure in organizing a secret society which, at the time of these events, was about sixteen years old. It was dedicated to nothing less than the quiet domination of the world. The conquest of Russia was seen as but the first phase of that plan. Since the organization is still in existence today and continues to make progress toward its goal, it is important to have its history included in this narrative.

One of the most authoritative reference works on the history of this group is *Tragedy and Hope* by Dr. Carroll Quigley. Dr. Quigley was a professor of history at Georgetown University where President Clinton had been one of his students. He was the author of the widely used textbook, *Evolution of Civilization*; he was a member of the editorial board of the monthly periodical, *Current History*; and he was a frequent lecturer and consultant for such groups as the Industrial College of the Armed Forces, the Brookings Institution, the U.S. Naval Weapons Laboratory, the Naval College, the Smithsonian Institute, and the State Department. But Dr. Quigley was no mere academic. He also had been closely associated with many of the family dynasties of the super-rich. He was, by his own boast, an insider with a front row view of the world's money power structure.

When Dr. Quigley wrote his scholarly, 1300-page book of dry history, it was not intended for the masses. It was to be read by the intellectual elite, and to that select readership he cautiously exposed one of the best-kept secrets of all time. He also made it clear, however, that he was a friendly apologist for this group and that he supported its goals and purposes. Dr. Quigley said:

I know of the operation of this network because I have studied it for twenty years and was permitted for two years, in the 1960s, to examine its papers and secret records. I have no aversion to it or to most of its aims and have, for much of my life, been close to it and to many of its instruments.... In general, my chief difference of opinion is that it wishes to remain unknown.¹

As mentioned, Quigley's book was intended for an elite readership composed of scholars and network insiders. But, unexpectedly, it began to be quoted in the journals of the John Birch Society, which correctly had perceived that his work provided a valuable insight to the inner workings of a hidden power structure. That exposure triggered a large demand for the book by people who were opposed to the network and curious to see what an insider had

to say about it. That was not according to the original plan. What happened next is best described by Quigley, himself. In a personal letter dated December 9, 1975, he wrote:

Thank you for your praise of *Tragedy and Hope*, a book which has brought me headaches as it apparently says something which powerful people do not want known. My publisher stopped selling it in 1968 and told me he would reprint (but in 1971 he told my lawyer that they had destroyed the plates in 1968). The rare-book price went

up to \$135 and parts were reprinted in violation of copyright, but I could do nothing because I believed the publisher, and he would not take action even when a pirate copy of the book appeared. Only when I hired a lawyer in 1974 did I get any answers to my questions....

In another personal letter, Quigley commented further on the duplicity of his publisher:

They lied to me for six years, telling me that they would reprint when they got 2,000 orders, which could never happen because they told anyone who asked that it was out of print and would not be reprinted. They denied this to me until I sent them Xerox copies of such replies in libraries, at which they told me it was a clerk's error. In other words, they lied to me but prevented me from regaining publication rights.... I am now quite sure that *Tragedy and Hope* was suppressed....

To understand why "powerful people" would want to suppress this book, note carefully what follows. Dr. Quigley describes the goal of this network of world financiers as:

... nothing less than to create a world system of financial control in private hands able to dominate the political system of each country and the economy of the world as a whole. This system was to be controlled in a feudalist fashion by the central banks of the world acting in concert, by secret agreements arrived at in frequent private meetings and conferences....

Each central bank, in the hands of men like Montagu Norman of the Bank of England, Benjamin Strong of the New York Federal Reserve Bank, Charles Rist of the Bank of France, and Hjalmar Schacht of the Reichsbank, sought to dominate its government by its ability to control treasury loans, to manipulate foreign exchanges, to influence the level of economic activity in the country, and to influence cooperative politicians by subsequent economic rewards in the business world.²

1. These letters were first published in the Summer, 1976, issue of *Conspiracy Digest*, published by Peter McAlpine (Alpine Press, Dearborn, Michigan). The originals cannot now be located. However, the author was able to locate the attorney, Mr. Paul Wolff (with the firm of Williams & Connolly in Washington, D.C.) who represented Quigley in his legal action against the publisher. Mr. Wolff cannot vouch for the authenticity of the letters themselves, but has confirmed in phone conversations and later in writing that the essential details are correct. He writes: "It is my recollection that they withheld from me and the Professor for some time the information that they had in fact destroyed 'the plates.'"

That is the information that "powerful people" do not want the common man to know.

Notice that Quigley refers to this group as a "network." That is a precise choice of words, and it is important to an understanding of the forces of international finance. The network to which he refers is *not* the secret society. It is no doubt *directed by it*, and there are society members in key positions within the network, but we can be sure that there are many in the network who have little or no knowledge of hidden control. To explain how this can be possible, let us turn to the origin and growth of the secret society itself.

RUSKIN, RHODES, AND MILNER

(In 1870,) a wealthy British socialist by the name of John Ruskin was appointed as professor of fine arts at Oxford University in London. He taught that the state must take control of the means of production and organize them for the good of the community as a whole. He advocated placing control of the state into the hands of a small ruling class, perhaps even a single dictator. He said: "My continual aim has been to show the eternal superiority of some men to others, sometimes even of one man to all others."¹

This, of course, is the same intellectual appeal of Communism. Lenin taught that the masses could not be trusted to handle their own affairs and that a special group of disciplined intellectuals must assume this role for them. That is the function of the Communist Party, which never comprises more than about three per cent of the population. Even when the charade of free elections is allowed, only members of the Party—or those over whom the KGB has total control—are permitted to run for office. The concept that a ruling party or class is the ideal structure for society is at the heart of all collectivist schemes, regardless of whether they are called Socialism, Communism, Nazism, Fascism, or any other "ism" which may yet be invented to disguise it. It is easy, therefore, for adherents of this elitist mentality to be comfortable in almost

any of these collectivist camps, a fact to which Dr. Quigley alluded when he wrote: "This network, which we may identify as the Round Table Groups, has no aversion to cooperating with the Communists, or any other groups, and frequently does so."²

Returning to the subject of the origins of this group, however, Dr. Quigley tells us:

Ruskin spoke to the Oxford undergraduates as members of the privileged ruling class. He told them that they were the possessors of a magnificent tradition of education, beauty, rule of law, freedom, decency, and self-discipline, but that this tradition could not be saved, and did not deserve to be saved, unless it could be extended to the lower classes in England itself and to the non-English masses throughout the world.

Ruskin's message had a sensational impact. His inaugural lecture was copied out in long-hand by one undergraduate, Cecil Rhodes, who kept it with him for thirty years.¹

Cecil Rhodes made one of the world's greatest fortunes. With the cooperation of the Bank of England and financiers like Rothschild, he was able to establish a virtual monopoly over the diamond output of South Africa and most of the gold as well. The major portion of this vast income was spent to advance the ruling-class ideas of John Ruskin.

Dr. Quigley explains:

The Rhodes Scholarships, established by the terms of Cecil Rhodes' seventh will, are known to everyone. What is not so widely known is that Rhodes in five previous wills left his fortune to form a secret society, which was to devote itself to the preservation and expansion of the British Empire. And what does not seem to be known to anyone is that this secret society was created by Rhodes and his principal trustee, Lord Milner, and continues to exist to this day.... In his book on Rhodes' wills, he [Stead, who was a member of the inner circle] wrote in one place: "Mr. Rhodes was more than the founder of a dynasty. He aspired to be the creator of one of those vast semi-religious, quasi-political associations which, like the Society of Jesus, have played so large a part in the history of the world. To be more strictly accurate, he wished to found an Order as the instrument of the will of the Dynasty."²...

In this secret society Rhodes was to be leader; Stead, Brett (Lord Esher), and Milner were to form an executive committee; Arthur (Lord) Balfour, (Sir) Harry Johnston, Lord Rothschild, Albert (Lord) Grey, and others were listed as potential members of a "Circle of Initiates;" while there was to be an outer circle known as the

"Association of Helpers" (later organized by Milner as the Round Table organization).

THE PATTERN OF CONSPIRACY

Here, then, was the classical pattern of political conspiracy. This was the structure that made it possible for Quigley to differentiate between an international "network" and the secret society *within* that network. At the center, there is always a tiny group in complete control, with one man as the undisputed leader. Next is a circle of secondary leadership that, for the most part, is unaware of an inner core. They are led to believe that *they* are the inner-most ring.

In time, as these conspiracies are built from the center out, they form additional rings of organization. Those in the outer echelons usually are idealists with an honest desire to improve the world. They never suspect an inner control for other purposes, and only those few who demonstrate a ruthless capacity for higher leadership are ever allowed to see it.

After the death of Cecil Rhodes, the inner core of his secret society fell under the control of Lord Alfred Milner, Governor-General and High Commissioner of South Africa. As director of a number of public banks and as corporate precursor of England's Midland Bank, he became one of the greatest political and financial powers in the world. Milner recruited into his secret society a group of young men chiefly from Oxford and Toynbee Hall and, according to Quigley:

Through his influence these men were able to win influential posts in government and international finance and became the dominant influence in British imperial and foreign affairs up to 1939.... In 1909-1913 they organized semi-secret groups, known as Round Table Groups, in the chief British dependencies and the United States....

Money for the widely ramified activities of this organization came ... chiefly from the Rhodes Trust itself, and from wealthy associates such as the Beit brothers, from Sir Abe Bailey, and (after 1915) from the Astor family ... and from foundations and firms associated with the international banking fraternity, especially the Carnegie United Kingdom Trust, and other organizations associated with J.P. Morgan, the Rockefeller and Whitney families, and the associates of Lazard Brothers and of Morgan, Grenfell, and Company....

At the end of the war of 1914, it became clear that the organization of this system had to be greatly extended. Once again the task was entrusted to Lionel Curtis who established, in England and each dominion, a front organization to the existing local Round Table Group. This front organization, called the Royal Institute of International Affairs, had as its nucleus in each area the existing submerged Round Table Group. In New York it was known as the Council on Foreign Relations, and was a front for J.P. Morgan and Company in association with the very small American Round Table Group.¹

The Council on Foreign Relations was a spin-off from the failure of the world's leaders at the end of World War I to embrace the League of Nations as a true world government. It became clear to the master planners that they had been unrealistic in their expectations for rapid acceptance. If their plan were to be carried forward, it would have to be done on the basis of patient gradualism symbolized by the Fabian turtle. Rose Martin says: X

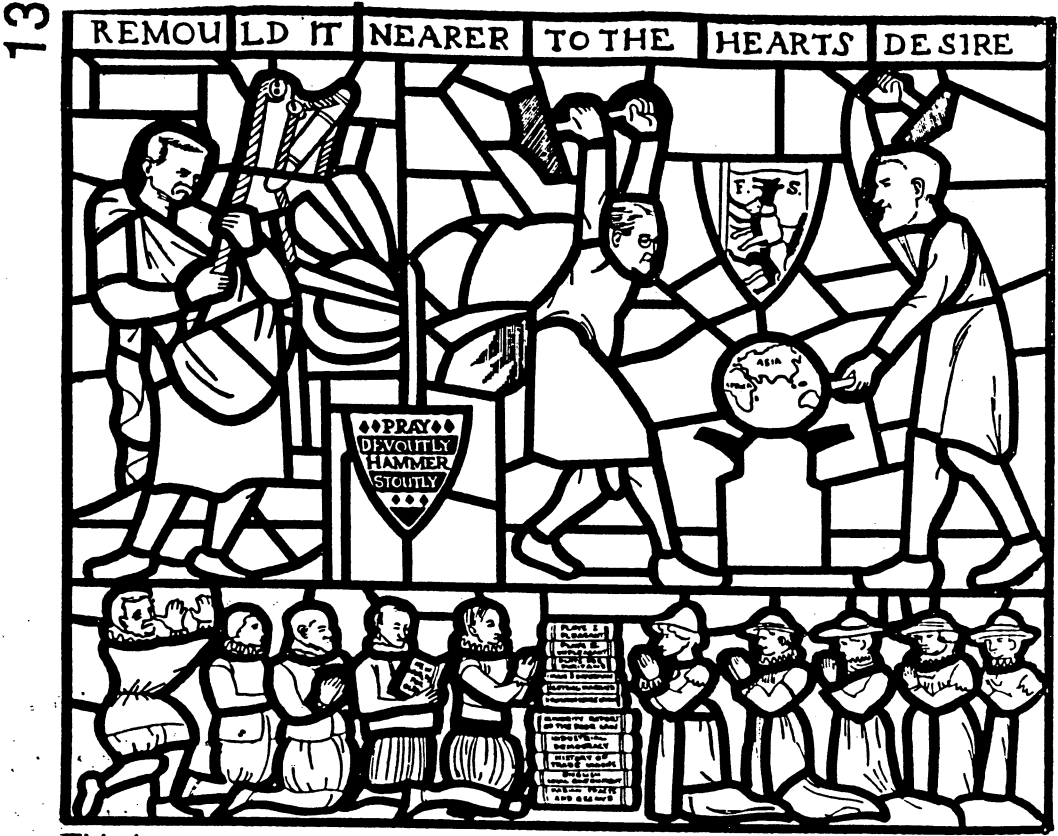

The Fabians were an elite group of intellectuals who agreed with Communists as to the goal of socialism but disagreed over tactics. Whereas Communists advocated revolution by force and violence, Fabians advocated gradualism and the transformation of society through legislation. The slow-moving turtle became their symbol; their crest portrayed a wolf in sheep's clothing.

It was learned in later years that Harry Dexter White was a member of a Communist espionage ring. Thus, hidden from view, there was a complex drama taking place in which the two intellectual founders of the Bretton-Woods accords were a Fabian Socialist and a Communist, working together to bring about their mutual goal: world socialism.

group of Fabian-certified Englishmen—notably, Arnold Toynbee, R.H. Tawney and John Maynard Keynes. All were equally disillusioned, for various reasons, by the consequences of the peace. They made a gentlemen's agreement to set up an organization, with branches in England and America, "to facilitate the scientific study of international questions." As a result two potent and closely related opinion-making bodies were founded.... The English branch was called the Royal Institute of International Affairs. The American branch, first known as the Institute of International Affairs, was reorganized in 1921 as the Council on Foreign Relations.²

It is through this front group, called the Council on Foreign Relations, and its influence over the media, tax-exempt foundations, universities, and government agencies that the international financiers have been able to dominate the domestic and foreign policies of the United States ever since.

We shall have more to say about the CFR, but our focal point for now is Great Britain and, in particular, the help given to Communism in Russia by Lord Alfred Milner and his web of secret societies.

ROUND TABLE AGENTS IN RUSSIA

In Russia, prior to and during the revolution, there were many local observers, tourists, and newsmen who reported that British and American agents were everywhere, particularly in Petrograd, providing money for insurrection. One report said, for example, that British agents were seen handing out 25-rouble notes to the men at the Pavlovski regiment just a few hours before it mutinied against its officers and sided with the revolution. The subsequent publication of various memoirs and documents made it clear that this funding was provided by Milner and channeled through Sir George Buchanan who was the British Ambassador to Russia at that time.¹ It was a repeat of the ploy that had worked so well for the cabal many times in the past. Round Table members were once again working *both* sides of the conflict to weaken and topple a target government. Tsar Nicholas had every reason to believe that, since the British were Russia's allies in the war against Germany, British officials would be the last persons on Earth to conspire against him. Yet, the British Ambassador himself represented the hidden group which was financing the regime's downfall.

Colonel House was only one man, where a multitude was needed. He had set the pattern and outlined goals for the future, and he still had a scheme or two in mind. In particular, he foresaw it would be necessary for the Fabians to develop a top level Anglo-American planning group in the field of foreign relations which could secretly influence policy on the one hand and gradually "educate" public opinion on the other....

To the ambitious young Fabians, British and American, who had flocked to the peace conference as economists and junior officials, it soon became evident that a New World Order was not about to be produced at Paris.... For them, Colonel House arranged a dinner meeting at the Hotel Majestic on May 19, 1919, together with a select

The plan for world domination continues apace across the planet today as the secret armies are trained and prepared with government funding behind fake names and fake projects. One of these in the United States is called the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). This has a budget of billions of dollars, and yet it wasn't even created under constitutional law. It is the result of a Presidential Executive Order. In 1935, the Emergency Management Act was passed to give the President the right to by-pass Congress and make laws in times of national emergency. Fair enough, you might think. Sometimes you have to act quickly when there's an emergency. The little point they don't tell you is that there is *always* officially a state of national emergency in the United States! This gives the President powers to make laws whenever he wishes, and have them ready and waiting for the time when they can all be implemented at once. You might like to know that these executive orders passed since 1935 have given the President the power to do the following, whenever he decides there is increased international tension or economic crisis:

To take over all transport, roads, and ports; all media; the power industries; food production and farms; all aircraft; relocate communities and mobilise people into work brigades under government supervision; start a national registration scheme.

The list goes on, and when a state of emergency is declared by the President, Congress cannot challenge it for at least six months.

"He (the President) will have the right to propose temporary laws, and even new departures in the government constitutional working, the pretext both for the one and other being the requirements for the supreme welfare of the State....."

"We shall invest in the president the right to declare a state of war. We shall justify this last right on the ground that the president as chief of the whole army of the country must have it at his disposal for the defence of the.....constitution." (Illuminati Protocol 10).

FEMA came into being this way. It was started by.....Zbigniew Brzezinski; remember him? He started the Trilateral Commission with Rockefeller money, and served as National Security Advisor

for the first Trilateralist President, Jimmy Carter. Brzezinski stayed on after Carter's defeat, to continue his work with FEMA under Ronald Reagan. FEMA's public face is presented as an organisation that reacts to national emergencies – everything from a nuclear attack to an earthquake or an urban riot. Strange then, you might think, that only six percent of its budget is spent on national emergencies. The rest is used to construct underground facilities for the government in time of 'foreign or domestic' emergency, and to build 'holding facilities', prisons and 'refugee facilities', none of which have ever been used for such purposes. So why are they building them? FEMA has around 3,600 employees, and yet only sixty work on natural disasters or prepare plans in case of nuclear attack. What are the rest doing?

Two familiar names were in charge of FEMA for a number of years: General Richard Secord and Colonel Oliver North, who worked with the CIA and US Air Force to smuggle weapons (and what else?) in what became known as the Iran-Contra Affair. FEMA is another major arm of the secret government. One of its aims is to disarm the American people. Now, I'm all for getting rid of weapons of all kinds, but again you need to look at the motives behind it. If you are planning a takeover, a coup against what passes for a democratic order, then it is much easier if the population is unarmed. And what do you need to justify laws taking away the public's right to own a gun under American law? More violent, high profile crime. Exactly what you need to justify the arming of police forces like those of Britain, which have not carried arms as a matter of course in the past. Incidentally, the American Gun Control Act of 1968 is word for word the Nazi Gun Control Law of 1938.

Another branch of the secret government working with FEMA is the Multi-Jurisdictional Task Force (MJTF), which was started by President George Bush. Bill Clinton talks of the need for a national police force when he already has one. The MJTF is now in almost all American states, and its role is house-to-house searches, the seizure and 'categorising' of men, women and children, and their transfer to detention centres (built by FEMA, remember), and the interrogation of these people. We are talking about concentration camps here, ladies and gentlemen. Twenty-three such camps were authorised originally and another twenty were allowed for under the 1990-91 military budget. The MJTF recruits from urban street gangs, who are now allowed to do legally what

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they have been doing illegally for most of their lives, to enter homes, take possessions etc. They are too stupid to see that they are being used, and that they will be removed too, when their purpose is served.

The third element in this triangle is the Financial Crime Enforcement Network (FINCEN). This is made up mostly of people from overseas police forces and military, particularly European. FINCEN in Montana has a number of Gurkhas in its ranks. They have thousands of helicopters and other aircraft at their disposal, which are appropriately painted black. Many times, black helicopters have been seen near the occurrence of cattle mutilations which are said to be the work of ETs. FINCEN personnel are trained to land, do their dark deeds, and then disappear into the sky very quickly. The Brotherhood-controlled United Nations is supporting and helping to coordinate these operations. All it takes is one major manufactured 'crisis', and the starting gun fires. Goodbye democracy, or what claims to be democracy. I understand the plans for the takeover of the United States are now well advanced. There will come a time when you will know that I am right but for now it is given to me to speak the bitter truth because after many years of studying this, the evidence is overwhelming and yet at this time I'm sure you will not understand. because if you did you would have been so outraged by now that you would have taken action. Nevertheless without a speck of hesitation I know what I have to do. I will be the voice of the American People until they awaken to the massive war of subversion being waged against them by demented european powers. And when the American People awaken I'm sure that they, will be able to speak for themselves. Near the end of this report I will prove beyond doubt that the federal entity, is conspiring with these foreign powers to overthrow the United States of America.

I am now ordering 30 million people to go to Washington DC to demand that The National Directives be carried out. Every single person will carry an American Flag. Then we will bring the matter to court and bring forward all the crimes and acts of treason committed by the federal entity since it surrendered control of the nation's currency into the hands of foreigners none of whom were sworn uphold our Constitution. Blessed are the meek, for they, shall not be Divided. And in not being Divided what they build Shall Last.

This report activates the process whereby the people shall create an everlasting constitution.

As National Officer in Charge it is necessary to confront and defeat all aspects of the beast that calls itself a new world order. The beast has caused distabilization through various weak points in our constitution. A constitution which was written under circumstances totally unlike those of our day.

Therefore the information I place on public record begins to clarify the constitutional issues, that we must take on the responsibility for dealing with.

On another related note I am hereby ordering the Secretary of Defense to deliver \$40,000,000,000 dollars to the United States Treasury to be released at my command for use in facilitating the people's efforts in regard to the development of the everlasting constitution and to assist the people in preparing for other necessary future activities.

I am now canceling all active presidential executive emergency orders and declaring that anyone implementing them without my sanction will be charged with treason.

Are The Problems of American Government Due To A Now-Inadequate U.S. Constitution? *If So, Should The Constitution Be Rewritten?*

(An Introductory Note by Free Press Editor Art Kunkin:

Until I read the article below, first published as an editorial in the March 1996 issue of Harper's Magazine, I believed that only very reactionary right-wing conservatives interested in nullifying the Bill of Rights and imposing a totalitarian government on the American people proposed rewriting the U.S. Constitution. Along with most other Americans, I consider the Constitution as amended by the Bill of Rights to be a very important guarantee of political and social democracy. So when a very large number of State Legislatures in the middle 1960's passed resolutions calling for a Constitutional Convention to rewrite the U.S. Constitution so that it would include a balanced budget provision they wanted, I wrote a Los Angeles Free Press editorial against that proposal. I based my argument on the opinion of constitutional experts who said that there was a real danger that a Constitutional Convention called to change government on one issue would have, or could assume, the legal authority to replace the existing Constitution with a far more undemocratic document.

Then I read the article we publish below and changed my mind somewhat. I began to appreciate that however valuable the present Constitution is as a general mission statement for freedom and individual rights, the detailed description in the Constitution of the much applauded system of checks and balances between the executive, the legislative branches and the judiciary may be ultimately responsible for the paralysis of American government and the corruption which angers the American people today.

In other words, it may be possible that the present day distrust of government by the majority of Americans has at its roots, at least in part, a Constitution which was originally written by an elite group of rich white men who feared democratic government (hence no voting rights originally for non-property owners, for women or for black slaves, and no Bill of Rights until it was forced upon them through the first ten amendments) and who even established an undemocratic Electoral College that threatens to invalidate the popular vote in every presidential election and who, furthermore and perhaps most important, deliberately divided the national government into an executive office, two legislative bodies and a judiciary to create a very weak national government that would allow a hidden economic elite to be the real rulers.

Posing these issues as questions, do we need to rewrite and replace our 200 year old Constitution with a more modern mission statement and procedures to ensure a better functioning and more responsive government? With every major corporation in the United States finding it necessary to reformulate their mission statements and procedures as the new century approaches, with almost every other government in the world functioning with constitutions that were newly formulated after World War Two, can we in the United States solve our twenty-first-century problems with an eighteenth-century Constitution based on seventeenth-century principles?

★ But if a new Constitution may prove to be an essential part of the solution to our present problems, we obviously will have to be very careful to avoid throwing out the baby when disposing of the dirty bath water! The present Constitution is widely and properly accepted as a historic mission statement for freedom and individualism. If this Constitution is found wanting, it must not be replaced by a document that will establish a dictatorship of any kind. Therefore, the American people must have as much time as possible, and we believe starting immediately, to discuss the good and possibly bad aspects of the present

U.S. Constitution before any decisions are made about a new Constitution. In the spirit of these very fundamental questions, we provide for our readers the full text of the Harper's Magazine editorial. And to continue our participation in this very important discussion, we plan to further review and possibly reprint excerpts from the very important book by Daniel Lazare which is cited by Mr Lapham at the beginning of his editorial. Old-time religion

What we wanted, we did not know; what we knew, we did not want.
--Ernst Von Salomon

During a presidential election year I expect the books published on political themes to read like the speeches at a Fourth of July picnic--heartwarming cant as plentiful as the beer and as empty as the balloons--but six weeks before the New Hampshire primaries I discovered "The Frozen Republic: How The Constitution Is Paralyzing Democracy," by Daniel Lazare to be the exception that proves the rule.

In the sanctuary of the American civil religion nothing except a private fortune in excess of \$5 Billion is more precious than the four pages of parchment brought forth by the corporate sponsors of liberty in Philadelphia in the summer of 1787. Lazare, an accomplished iconoclast, manages within the space of a few hundred pages to assign them to the realm of magical objects in which a museum of natural history also might place the totem poles, the scraps of sacred moleskin, and the bones of a departed saint. I'm not enough of a constitutional scholar to find the flaws in Lazare's legal reasoning, but his knowledge of American history is as persuasive as his wit and, despite his lack of academic connections and provenience in the often ideological left (as a columnist for The Village Voice and the New York editor of In These Times, I was glad to encounter a writer willing to suggest that only by reconfiguring our system of government (i.e. by rewriting the Constitution) can we address what by now have become the all too obvious consequence of our political weaknesses and stupidity.

The proposition seems to me to stand as proven in any morning's newspaper. At least one story in every four speaks to the presence of a constitutional crisis that we pretend not to notice but which accurately defines the enfeebled state of our national politics--the federal government twice shut down in the early winter because of a quarrel about a balanced budget (i.e., a metaphysical dispute about a set of wholly imaginery numbers), the futility of a Congress unable to negotiate a disarmament treaty with a citizenry possessed of 200 million guns, the selling off of the public lands despite the objections of at least 60% of the nominally sovereign American people, the notion of legitimate political authority so far from anybody's mind that the office of the presidency can be bought at a price well below that of a second-rate company or a losing football team.

Lazare arranges his polemic in historical sequence--the origins of the Constitution as a marvel of eighteenth-century political mechanics made to the design of seventeenth-century religious belief, the

impious (and unanswerable) questions forced on its infallible authority by the Civil War, the desperate denials of the document's obvious imperfections during the era of American ascendance following the victories in the Second World War, the blind worship of the sacred text that has accompanied the last fifty years of the country's descent into bankruptcy and the wisdom of Rush Limbaugh.

Three of Lazare's points about the obsolete and the undemocratic character of the Constitution strike me as useful glosses on a presidential campaign likely to present the owner of Forbes Magazine as the friend of the common man.

1. Virtuous Incapacity

Listening to a politician talk, or while reading an indignant editorial in an earnest newspaper, the trusting citizen might make the mistake of thinking that the government was supposed to work--as if political power were a form of energy (like diesel fuel or department store credit) meant to be used for a constructive purpose. The supposition is false, but it gives rise to the chorus of complaint (about crime and drugs and federal fraud, or the cities falling into ruins and the suburbs foundering in the morass of debt, or the failures of will and the lack of an ennobling moral vision) that accompanies the ritual of an American election. The complaints goad the candidates to promises of reform, which supply the news media with headlines, but have nothing to do with anything other than their own reflection in the public opinion polls.

The government was never supposed to work, at least not in the ways imagined by a municipal planning commission. The political shambles is deliberate, and the government's incompetence a testimony to its virtue. The gentlemen who wrote the Constitution were as suspicious of efficient government as they were wary of democracy, a "turbulence and a folly" that they associated with the unruly ignorance of an urban mob. They looked upon political power as a corrupting influence--in much the same way that William Bennett and Pat Buchanan look upon the evil of crack cocaine--and they belonged by temperament to what in seventeenth-century England would have been understood as "The Country Party"--well-to-do gentry, many of them Puritans, who opposed, on principle as well as for reasons of interest, what was known as "The Court Party." Lazare cites Lawrence Stone's *The Causes of the English Revolution* on the division between the two parties, a division that continues to define, much to our misfortune and nearly 350 years after Charles I lost his head, the ideal and anti-ideal of the American political dream:

"The Country was peaceful and clean, a place of grass and trees and birds, the city (on the other hand) was ugly and dirty and noisy, a place of clattering cars and coaches, coal dust and smog, and piles of human excrement....the Country was virtuous, the Court wicked; the Country was thrifty, the Court extravagant; the Country was honest, the Court corrupt; the Country was chaste and heterosexual, the Court promiscuous and homosexual; the Country was sober, the Court drunken...the Country was outspoken, the Court sycophantic; the Country was the defender of the old ways and old liberties, the Court the promoter of administrative novelties and new tyrannical practices..."

Like their descendants on both our own Arcadian left and Suburban right, the wealthy American planters and merchants who wrote the Constitution associated themselves with the purity of the Country Party. Believing themselves morally and intellectually superior to the democratic rabble, they defined the practice of government as the duty of the judicious few to control and improve the instincts of the foolish many, and they undertook to render the federal political power as impotent as a eunuch in the court of a Ming emperor. Power was to be kept out of the hands of children (also known as the sovereign people) and anybody as likely as Alexander Hamilton to make of government an efficient instrument of intelligible purpose.

Hamilton was a forward-looking man who assumed that the events looming below the horizon of the future would best be met by a strong government and a flexible constitution. Jefferson imagined that America in 1900 would look much the way it looked in 1800 and, with more or less the same pastoral prospect in mind, the editorial committee in Philadelphia conceived the portrait of the American future as a romantic reconstruction of the Roman or Tudor past. Toward that idyllic end they produced a government weak enough to preserve the institution of slavery and a Constitution rigid enough to resist the invasions of social change. The Preamble granted unlimited powers to "We the People," but Article V (the clause that make amendment virtually impossible by requiring a two-thirds vote in both houses of Congress and ratification by three-fourths of the states) declared the Preamble null and void. Denied the means of revising what suddenly had become an immutable and ancient law, the newly independent Americans enjoyed even less freedom to alter the course of their destiny than the subjects of George III.

2. *Balanced Impotence*

By containing the powers of government in a mechanism as finely balanced as a late seventeenth-century ornamental clock, the authors of the Constitution distributed political energy among so many weights and counterweights that nobody could say for certain how the movement originated or where sovereignty was to be found. Let the several functions of government work at cross purposes (the legislature against the executive, the executive against the legislature, and the judiciary against anyone it chose) and with any luck they would hold one another indefinitely at bay. Political power divided into as many parts as the fragments of the True Cross couldn't interfere with the economic power, and the marvelous state of suspended animation served everybody's interests as long as everyone agreed that the private good was another name for the public good. But the practice of keeping slaves presented the gentlemen in Philadelphia with a contradiction for which their Constitution had no answer (human liberty on the one hand, and private property on the other), and the absence of a political means of addressing the question resulted, seventy-four years later, in the Civil War and more than 600,000 dead.

Contrary to Lord Acton's often quoted dictum about the corruption inherent in absolute power (i.e., the "tyrannous and arbitrary power" dreaded by the eighteenth-century American gentry and reviled by the teachers of twentieth-century American civics lessons), concentrated power can be plainly seen and (if the opposition has the courage to do so) held to account. Power broken into a thousand pieces can be hidden and disowned. If no individual or institution possesses the authority to act without the consent of everybody else in the room, then nobody is ever at fault if anything goes wrong. Congress can blame the President, the President can blame the Congress or the Supreme Court, the Supreme Court can blame the Mexicans or the weather in Ohio.

Checked and balanced by powers of all denominations, the country's public servants become, in theory, accountable to everybody; in practice they remain accountable to nobody, "dithering and indecisive, borne aloft on great billows of empty rhetoric," free to strike attractive moral attitudes while at the same time selling their votes to the highest corporate bidder. By further complicating the proceedings with congressional committees and subcommittees (now numbering nearly 300) and a myriad of federal, state, regulatory, regional, and district government entities blessed with the authority to levy and collect taxes (at last count numbering at least 83,000 in the United States), the machinery of divided government disperses even the semblance of responsibility into a haze of impotent recrimination.

3. *The God in the Machine*

Lazare traces the fervor of our present constitutional devotions to the complacency that settled on the American mind in the years immediately following the Second World War, and he begins his chapter on

the consequences of that complacency with the observation that "the only thing more dangerous than total defeat is total victory." The winning of the war prompted Americans to think that their military and industrial supremacy was proof of their moral and political virtue and, by 1953, Daniel Boorstin, the historian soon to become the Librarian of Congress, was attributing what he called "the genius of American politics" to Divine Providence:

"...It is not surprising that we have no enthusiasm for plans to make society over. We have actually made a new society without a plan. Or, more precisely, why should we make a five-year plan for ourselves when God seems to have had a thousand-year plan ready for us."

Almost everybody else in the country at the time, Democrat and Republican as well as liberal and conservative held to similar beliefs--God was in his heaven, all was right in the world, America was great because it was America, and the Constitution had been brought to Washington in a glass box by the Archangel Gabriel. The less fortunate nations of the earth might have to suffer the indignity of realigning their political thought with the events of the second half of the twentieth century--in the last fifty years, new constitutions have appeared in Germany, France, Portugal, Holland, Sweden, Denmark, Russia and Japan--but the Americans, being American and therefore perfect, could afford to look upon the stately passing of recorded time with the serene indifference of Mt. Rushmore. What was the point of thinking seriously about politics when the country was being governed, as it had always been governed, by the magic parchment in the museum with George Washington's inkwell and Benjamin Franklin's wig?

The United States, in the meantime, fell behind every other country in the industrialized world in most of the categories that measure the well-being of a civilized society--the most brutal police force and the most crowded prisons, the harshest system of criminal justice, repressive drug laws, a lazy and sycophantic press. Over the span of the same fifty years, our political campaigns have come to resemble nothing so much as games of trivial pursuit, charades reduced to works of performance art in which the candidates smear one another with insults instead of chocolate.

All observations about the country falling off its marble pedestal were met by referrals to the Constitution. America was still the wonder of the world because our wealth made us wise, and because in its handsome display case in Washington, as miraculous as the engines aboard the Starship "*Enterprise*," the Constitution was protecting, by day as by night, the liberties of its chosen people. The assumption renders any further effort at political thought both unnecessary and impious.

Theocratic societies tend to have a weak grasp of reality, and toward the end of his book, remarking on the fulminations of the Country Party presently holding the majority in Congress, Lazare says, "All those Republican House freshmen in early 1995 who could be seen sporting copies of the Federalist Papers were not all that different from Iranian mullahs waving copies of the Koran." An historian rather than a political scientist or a first-year congressman, Lazare doesn't offer a set of instructions for redrafting the Constitution, but he carries his point about our idolatrous worship of the document, depriving us of the courage to imagine a future that doesn't look like one of the Disney Company's replicas of the nonexistent American past. The framers of the Constitution lived in a world innocent of electricity, jet airplanes, telephones, computers, nuclear weapons, and MTV; if their political mechanism had already become outworn by the middle of the nineteenth-century (i.e., incapable of resolving the question of slavery), then how can we expect it to address the questions likely to be presented by the twenty-first century?

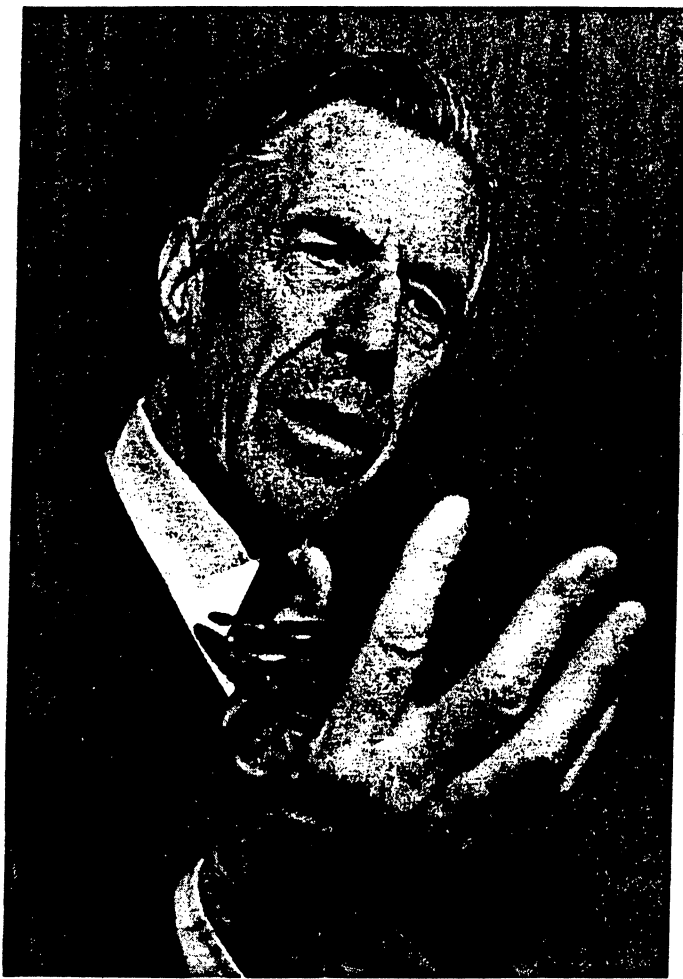

John Kenneth Galbraith, well-known historian and professor at Harvard, has verified that he was asked to be a part of the team that put together *The Report from Iron Mountain*, a think-tank study commissioned by the Defense Department. The purpose of the study was to explore novel ways of keeping the masses in subservience. When a copy of the *Report* was leaked to the press, the government claimed it was a hoax. Galbraith confirmed that it was totally authentic.

THE SECRET SOCIETY

Lord Alfred Milner was a key figure in organizing a secret society which, at the time of these events, was about sixteen years old. It was dedicated to nothing less than the quiet domination of the world. The conquest of Russia was seen as but the first phase of that plan. Since the organization is still in existence today and continues to make progress toward its goal, it is important to have its history included in this narrative.

One of the most authoritative reference works on the history of this group is *Tragedy and Hope* by Dr. Carroll Quigley. Dr. Quigley was a professor of history at Georgetown University where President Clinton had been one of his students. He was the author of the widely used textbook, *Evolution of Civilization*; he was a member of the editorial board of the monthly periodical, *Current History*; and he was a frequent lecturer and consultant for such groups as the Industrial College of the Armed Forces, the Brookings Institution, the U.S. Naval Weapons Laboratory, the Naval College, the Smithsonian Institute, and the State Department. But Dr. Quigley was no mere academic. He also had been closely associated with many of the family dynasties of the super-rich. He was, by his own boast, an insider with a front row view of the world's money power structure.

When Dr. Quigley wrote his scholarly, 1300-page book of dry history, it was not intended for the masses. It was to be read by the intellectual elite, and to that select readership he cautiously exposed one of the best-kept secrets of all time. He also made it clear, however, that he was a friendly apologist for this group and that he supported its goals and purposes. Dr. Quigley said:

I know of the operation of this network because I have studied it for twenty years and was permitted for two years, in the 1960s, to examine its papers and secret records. I have no aversion to it or to most of its aims and have, for much of my life, been close to it and to many of its instruments.... In general, my chief difference of opinion is that it wishes to remain unknown.¹

As mentioned, Quigley's book was intended for an elite readership composed of scholars and network insiders. But, unexpectedly, it began to be quoted in the journals of the John Birch Society, which correctly had perceived that his work provided a valuable insight to the inner workings of a hidden power structure. That exposure triggered a large demand for the book by people who were opposed to the network and curious to see what an insider had

to say about it. That was not according to the original plan. What happened next is best described by Quigley, himself. In a personal letter dated December 9, 1975, he wrote:

Thank you for your praise of *Tragedy and Hope*, a book which has brought me headaches as it apparently says something which powerful people do not want known. My publisher stopped selling it in 1968 and told me he would reprint (but in 1971 he told my lawyer that they had destroyed the plates in 1968). The rare-book price went

up to \$135 and parts were reprinted in violation of copyright, but I could do nothing because I believed the publisher, and he would not take action even when a pirate copy of the book appeared. Only when I hired a lawyer in 1974 did I get any answers to my questions....

In another personal letter, Quigley commented further on the duplicity of his publisher:

They lied to me for six years, telling me that they would reprint when they got 2,000 orders, which could never happen because they told anyone who asked that it was out of print and would not be reprinted. They denied this to me until I sent them Xerox copies of such replies in libraries, at which they told me it was a clerk's error. In other words, they lied to me but prevented me from regaining publication rights.... I am now quite sure that *Tragedy and Hope* was suppressed....

To understand why "powerful people" would want to suppress this book, note carefully what follows. Dr. Quigley describes the goal of this network of world financiers as:

... nothing less than to create a world system of financial control in private hands able to dominate the political system of each country and the economy of the world as a whole. This system was to be controlled in a feudalist fashion by the central banks of the world acting in concert, by secret agreements arrived at in frequent private meetings and conferences....

Each central bank, in the hands of men like Montagu Norman of the Bank of England, Benjamin Strong of the New York Federal Reserve Bank, Charles Rist of the Bank of France, and Hjalmar Schacht of the Reichsbank, sought to dominate its government by its ability to control treasury loans, to manipulate foreign exchanges, to influence the level of economic activity in the country, and to influence cooperative politicians by subsequent economic rewards in the business world.²

These letters were first published in the Summer, 1976, issue of *Conspiracy Digest*, published by Peter McAlpine (Alpine Press, Dearborn, Michigan). The originals cannot now be located. However, the author was able to locate the attorney, Mr. Paul Wolff (with the firm of Williams & Connolly in Washington, D.C.) who represented Quigley in his legal action against the publisher. Mr. Wolff cannot vouch for the authenticity of the letters themselves, but has confirmed in phone conversations and later in writing that the essential details are correct. He writes: "It is my recollection that they withheld from me and the Professor for some time the information that they had in fact destroyed 'the plates.'"

That is the information that "powerful people" do not want the common man to know.

Notice that Quigley refers to this group as a "network." That is a precise choice of words, and it is important to an understanding of the forces of international finance. The network to which he refers is *not* the secret society. It is no doubt *directed by it*, and there are society members in key positions within the network, but we can be sure that there are many in the network who have little or no knowledge of hidden control. To explain how this can be possible, let us turn to the origin and growth of the secret society itself.

RUSKIN, RHODES, AND MILNER

In 1870, a wealthy British socialist by the name of John Ruskin was appointed as professor of fine arts at Oxford University in London. He taught that the state must take control of the means of production and organize them for the good of the community as a whole. He advocated placing control of the state into the hands of a small ruling class, perhaps even a single dictator. He said: "My continual aim has been to show the eternal superiority of some men to others, sometimes even of one man to all others."¹

This, of course, is the same intellectual appeal of Communism. Lenin taught that the masses could not be trusted to handle their own affairs and that a special group of disciplined intellectuals must assume this role for them. That is the function of the Communist Party, which never comprises more than about three per cent of the population. Even when the charade of free elections is allowed, only members of the Party—or those over whom the KGB has total control—are permitted to run for office. The concept that a ruling party or class is the ideal structure for society is at the heart of all collectivist schemes, regardless of whether they are called Socialism, Communism, Nazism, Fascism, or any other "ism" which may yet be invented to disguise it. It is easy, therefore, for adherents of this elitist mentality to be comfortable in almost

any of these collectivist camps, a fact to which Dr. Quigley alluded when he wrote: "This network, which we may identify as the Round Table Groups, has no aversion to cooperating with the Communists, or any other groups, and frequently does so."²

Returning to the subject of the origins of this group, however, Dr. Quigley tells us:

Ruskin spoke to the Oxford undergraduates as members of the privileged ruling class. He told them that they were the possessors of a magnificent tradition of education, beauty, rule of law, freedom, decency, and self-discipline, but that this tradition could not be saved, and did not deserve to be saved, unless it could be extended to the lower classes in England itself and to the non-English masses throughout the world.

Ruskin's message had a sensational impact. His inaugural lecture was copied out in long-hand by one undergraduate, Cecil Rhodes, who kept it with him for thirty years.¹

Cecil Rhodes made one of the world's greatest fortunes. With the cooperation of the Bank of England and financiers like Rothschild, he was able to establish a virtual monopoly over the diamond output of South Africa and most of the gold as well. The major portion of this vast income was spent to advance the ruling-class ideas of John Ruskin.

Dr. Quigley explains:

The Rhodes Scholarships, established by the terms of Cecil Rhodes' seventh will, are known to everyone. What is not so widely known is that Rhodes in five previous wills left his fortune to form a secret society, which was to devote itself to the preservation and expansion of the British Empire. And what does not seem to be known to anyone is that this secret society was created by Rhodes and his principal trustee, Lord Milner, and continues to exist to this day.... In his book on Rhodes' wills, he [Stead, who was a member of the inner circle] wrote in one place: "Mr. Rhodes was more than the founder of a dynasty. He aspired to be the creator of one of those vast semi-religious, quasi-political associations which, like the Society of Jesus, have played so large a part in the history of the world. To be more strictly accurate, he wished to found an Order as the instrument of the will of the Dynasty."²...

In this secret society Rhodes was to be leader; Stead, Brett (Lord Esher), and Milner were to form an executive committee; Arthur (Lord) Balfour, (Sir) Harry Johnston, [Lord Rothschild, Albert (Lord) Grey, and others were listed as potential members of a "Circle of Initiates;" while there was to be an outer circle known as the

"Association of Helpers" (later organized by Milner as the Round Table organization).

THE PATTERN OF CONSPIRACY

Here, then, was the classical pattern of political conspiracy. This was the structure that made it possible for Quigley to differentiate between an international "network" and the secret society *within* that network. At the center, there is always a tiny group in complete control, with one man as the undisputed leader. Next is a circle of secondary leadership that, for the most part, is unaware of an inner core. They are led to believe that *they* are the inner-most ring.

In time, as these conspiracies are built from the center out, they form additional rings of organization. Those in the outer echelons usually are idealists with an honest desire to improve the world. They never suspect an inner control for other purposes, and only those few who demonstrate a ruthless capacity for higher leadership are ever allowed to see it.

After the death of Cecil Rhodes, the inner core of his secret society fell under the control of Lord Alfred Milner, Governor-General and High Commissioner of South Africa. As director of a number of public banks and as corporate precursor of England's Midland Bank, he became one of the greatest political and financial powers in the world. Milner recruited into his secret society a group of young men chiefly from Oxford and Toynbee Hall and, according to Quigley:

Through his influence these men were able to win influential posts in government and international finance and became the dominant influence in British imperial and foreign affairs up to 1939.... In 1909-1913 they organized semi-secret groups, known as Round Table Groups, in the chief British dependencies and the United States....

Money for the widely ramified activities of this organization came ... chiefly from the Rhodes Trust itself, and from wealthy associates such as the Beit brothers, from Sir Abe Bailey, and (after 1915) from the Astor family ... and from foundations and firms associated with the international banking fraternity, especially the Carnegie United Kingdom Trust, and other organizations associated with J.P. Morgan, the Rockefeller and Whitney families, and the associates of Lazard Brothers and of Morgan, Grenfell, and Company....

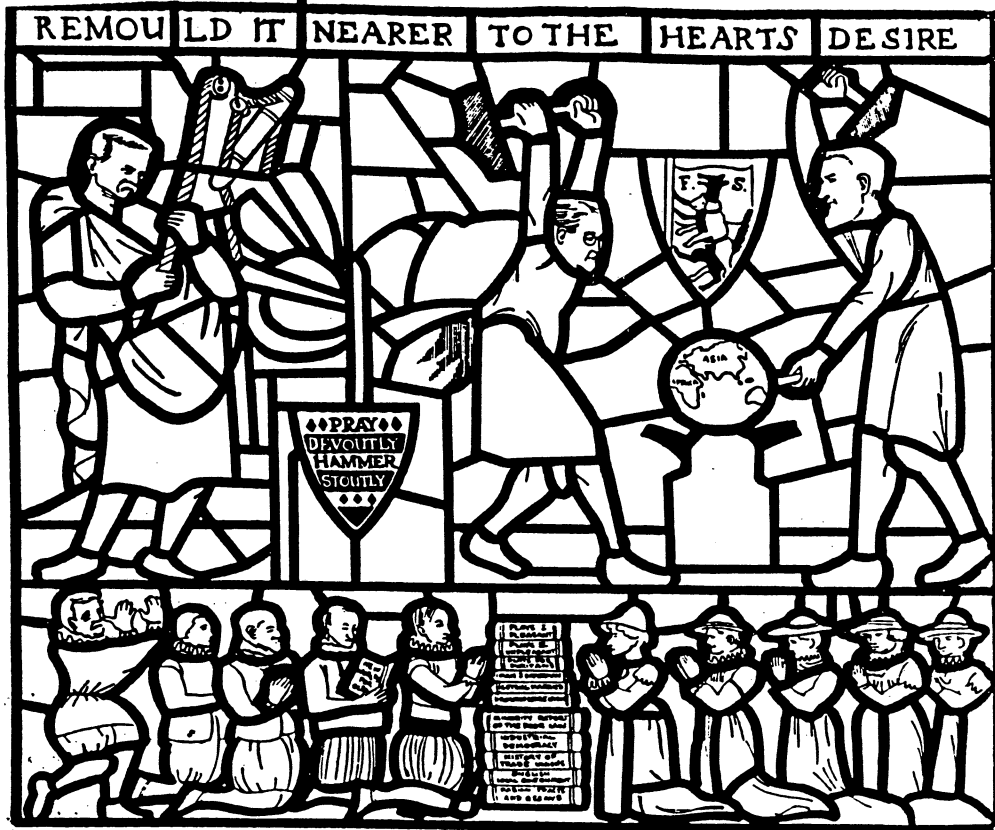
At the end of the war of 1914, it became clear that the organization of this system had to be greatly extended. Once again the task was entrusted to Lionel Curtis who established, in England and each dominion, a front organization to the existing local Round Table Group. This front organization, called the Royal Institute of International Affairs, had as its nucleus in each area the existing submerged Round Table Group. In New York it was known as the Council on Foreign Relations, and was a front for J.P. Morgan and Company in association with the very small American Round Table Group.¹

The Council on Foreign Relations was a spin-off from the failure of the world's leaders at the end of World War I to embrace the League of Nations as a true world government. It became clear to the master planners that they had been unrealistic in their expectations for rapid acceptance. If their plan were to be carried forward, it would have to be done on the basis of patient gradualism symbolized by the Fabian turtle. Rose Martin says: X

Separate insert about the Fabians

The Fabians were an elite group of intellectuals who agreed with Communists as to the goal of socialism but disagreed over tactics. Whereas Communists advocated revolution by force and violence, Fabians advocated gradualism and the transformation of society through legislation. The slow-moving turtle became their symbol; their crest portrayed a wolf in sheep's clothing.

It was learned in later years that Harry Dexter White was a member of a Communist espionage ring. Thus, hidden from view, there was a complex drama taking place in which the two intellectual founders of the Bretton-Woods accords were a Fabian Socialist and a Communist, working together to bring about their mutual goal: world socialism.

Colonel House was only one man, where a multitude was needed. He had set the pattern and outlined goals for the future, and he still had a scheme or two in mind. In particular, he foresaw it would be necessary for the Fabians to develop a top level Anglo-American planning group in the field of foreign relations which could secretly influence policy on the one hand and gradually "educate" public opinion on the other....

To the ambitious young Fabians, British and American, who had flocked to the peace conference as economists and junior officials, it soon became evident that a New World Order was not about to be produced at Paris.... For them, Colonel House arranged a dinner meeting at the Hotel Majestic on May 19, 1919, together with a select

group of Fabian-certified Englishmen—notably, Arnold Toynbee, R.H. Tawney and John Maynard Keynes. All were equally disillusioned, for various reasons, by the consequences of the peace. They made a gentlemen's agreement to set up an organization, with branches in England and America, "to facilitate the scientific study of international questions." As a result two potent and closely related opinion-making bodies were founded.... The English branch was called the Royal Institute of International Affairs. The American branch, first known as the Institute of International Affairs, was reorganized in 1921 as the Council on Foreign Relations.²

It is through this front group, called the Council on Foreign Relations, and its influence over the media, tax-exempt foundations, universities, and government agencies that the international financiers have been able to dominate the domestic and foreign policies of the United States ever since.

We shall have more to say about the CFR, but our focal point for now is Great Britain and, in particular, the help given to Communism in Russia by Lord Alfred Milner and his web of secret societies.

ROUND TABLE AGENTS IN RUSSIA

In Russia, prior to and during the revolution, there were many local observers, tourists, and newsmen who reported that British and American agents were everywhere, particularly in Petrograd, providing money for insurrection. One report said, for example, that British agents were seen handing out 25-rouble notes to the men at the Pavlovski regiment just a few hours before it mutinied against its officers and sided with the revolution. The subsequent publication of various memoirs and documents made it clear that this funding was provided by Milner and channeled through Sir George Buchanan who was the British Ambassador to Russia at that time.¹ It was a repeat of the ploy that had worked so well for the cabal many times in the past. Round Table members were once again working *both* sides of the conflict to weaken and topple a target government. Tsar Nicholas had every reason to believe that, since the British were Russia's allies in the war against Germany, British officials would be the last persons on Earth to conspire against him. Yet, the British Ambassador himself represented the hidden group which was financing the regime's downfall.

The Round Table agents from America did not have the advantage of using the diplomatic service as a cover and, therefore, had to be considerably more ingenious. They came, not as diplomats or even as interested businessmen, but disguised as Red Cross officials on a humanitarian mission. The group consisted almost entirely of financiers, lawyers, and accountants from New York banks and investment houses. They simply had overpowered the American Red Cross organization with large contributions and, in effect, purchased a franchise to operate in its name.

The plan for world domination continues apace across the planet today as the secret armies are trained and prepared with government funding behind fake names and fake projects. One of these in the United States is called the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). This has a budget of billions of dollars, and yet it wasn't even created under constitutional law. It is the result of a Presidential Executive Order. In 1935, the Emergency Management Act was passed to give the President the right to by-pass Congress and make laws in times of national emergency. Fair enough, you might think. Sometimes you have to act quickly when there's an emergency. The little point they don't tell you is that there is *always* officially a state of national emergency in the United States! This gives the President powers to make laws whenever he wishes, and have them ready and waiting for the time when they can all be implemented at once. You might like to know that these executive orders passed since 1935 have given the President the power to do the following, whenever he decides there is increased international tension or economic crisis:

To take over all transport, roads, and ports; all media; the power industries; food production and farms; all aircraft; re-locate communities and mobilise people into work brigades under government supervision; start a national registration scheme.

The list goes on, and when a state of emergency is declared by the President, Congress cannot challenge it for at least six months.

"He (the President) will have the right to propose temporary laws, and even new departures in the government constitutional working, the pretext both for the one and other being the requirements for the supreme welfare of the State....."

"We shall invest in the president the right to declare a state of war. We shall justify this last right on the ground that the president as chief of the whole army of the country must have it at his disposal for the defence of the.....constitution." (Illuminati Protocol 10).

FEMA came into being this way. It was started by.....Zbigniew Brzezinski; remember him? He started the Trilateral Commission with Rockefeller money, and served as National Security Advisor

for the first Trilateralist President, Jimmy Carter. Brzezinski stayed on after Carter's defeat, to continue his work with FEMA under Ronald Reagan. FEMA's public face is presented as an organisation that reacts to national emergencies – everything from a nuclear attack to an earthquake or an urban riot. Strange then, you might think, that only *six* percent of its budget is spent on national emergencies. The rest is used to construct underground facilities for the government in time of 'foreign or domestic' emergency, and to build 'holding facilities', prisons and 'refugee facilities', none of which have ever been used for such purposes. So why are they building them? FEMA has around 3,600 employees, and yet only sixty work on natural disasters or prepare plans in case of nuclear attack. What are the rest doing?

Two familiar names were in charge of FEMA for a number of years: General Richard Secord and Colonel Oliver North, who worked with the CIA and US Air Force to smuggle weapons (and what else?) in what became known as the Iran-Contra Affair. FEMA is another major arm of the secret government. One of its aims is to disarm the American people. Now, I'm all for getting rid of weapons of all kinds, but again you need to look at the motives behind it. If you are planning a takeover, a coup against what passes for a democratic order, then it is much easier if the population is unarmed. And what do you need to justify laws taking away the public's right to own a gun under American law? More violent, high profile crime. Exactly what you need to justify the arming of police forces like those of Britain, which have not carried arms as a matter of course in the past. Incidentally, the American Gun Control Act of 1968 is word for word the Nazi Gun Control Law of 1938.

Another branch of the secret government working with FEMA is the Multi-Jurisdictional Task Force (MJTF), which was started by President George Bush. Bill Clinton talks of the need for a national police force when he already has one. The MJTF is now in almost all American states, and its role is house-to-house searches, the seizure and 'categorising' of men, women and children, and their transfer to detention centres (built by FEMA, remember), and the interrogation of these people. We are talking about concentration camps here, ladies and gentlemen. Twenty-three such camps were authorised originally and another twenty were allowed for under the 1990-91 military budget. The MJTF recruits from urban street gangs, who are now allowed to do legally what

they have been doing illegally for most of their lives, to enter homes, take possessions etc. They are too stupid to see that they are being used, and that they will be removed too, when their purpose is served.

The third element in this triangle is the Financial Crime Enforcement Network (FINCEN). This is made up mostly of people from overseas police forces and military, particularly European. FINCEN in Montana has a number of Gurkhas in its ranks. They have thousands of helicopters and other aircraft at their disposal, which are appropriately painted black. Many times, black helicopters have been seen near the occurrence of cattle mutilations which are said to be the work of ETs. FINCEN personnel are trained to land, do their dark deeds, and then disappear into the sky very quickly. The Brotherhood-controlled United Nations is supporting and helping to coordinate these operations. All it takes is one major manufactured 'crisis', and the starting gun fires. Goodbye democracy, or what claims to be democracy. I understand the plans for the takeover of the United States are now well advanced. <p>The war of 1898 was fought in support of an oppressed country. The efforts of our government in this regard reached fruition in the convention of representatives of the nations of the earth at which the Charter of the United Nations was adopted. It was promptly ratified by the Senate of the United States, thereby proclaiming allegiance to its principles and providing precedent and example for other countries. The United States has consistently regarded its [treaties with other nations as inviolate.]</p> <p>The Charter has become "the supreme Law of the Land; and the Judges in every State shall be bound thereby, any Thing in the Constitution or Laws of any State to the Contrary notwithstanding." U.S. Const., Art. VI, sec. 2. The position of this country in the family of nations forbids trafficking in innocuous generalities but demands that every State in the Union accept and act upon the Charter according to its plain language and its unmistakable purpose and intent.</p>
