## AN ORDINANCE

In amendment to Chapter 2.84 -- Coordinating Council for Children, Youth, and Families (The Kids' Council) -- of the Cambridge Municipal Code.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:

1. Under Officers-Quorum-Adoption of rules and regulations-Committees, add at the end of section B:

**"If the Mayor chooses to have a co-chair, he or she may designate a co-chair from among Council members or from the community."**

After amendment. section B will read:

The Council shall be chaired by the Mayor. If the Mayor chooses not to chair, he or she will approve another Chairperson from among Council members. If the Mayor chooses to have a co-chair, he or she may designate a Co-chair from among Council Members or from the community.

2. Under Membership-Appointment-Term, add in part D after "School Committee Members:'

1. Under Officers-Quorum-Adoption of rules and regulations-Committees, add at the end of section B:

**"If the Mayor chooses to have a co-chair, he or she may designate a co-chair from among Council members or from the community."**

After amendment. section B will read:

The Council shall be chaired by the Mayor. If the Mayor chooses not to chair, he or she will approve another Chairperson from among Council members. If the Mayor chooses to have a co-chair, he or she may designate a Co-chair from among Council Members or from the community.

2. Under Membership-Appointment-Term, add in part D after "School Committee Members:'

**"and a representative of the Mayor, if he or she so desires,"**
