Consideration will only be given to a faithful performance bond without limitations, on an accepted form, which when properly executed will receive the Commissioner's approval.

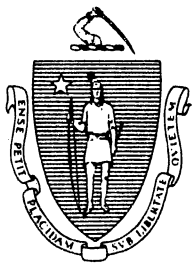

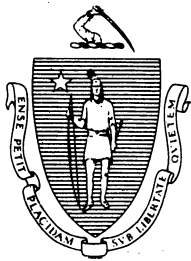
