I am happy to announce that the Community Development Department, through its Lead-Safe Cambridge program, was recently awarded an eight month lead education grant for \$35,214 from the Massachusetts Department of Public Health. This grant will be utilized to implement "Leaducate Cambridge" - a Cambridge based public information campaign which targets tenants, property owners and home renovators.

"Leaducate Cambridge" is a unique opportunity for the City to employ innovative outreach and education strategies while augmenting existing Lead-Safe Cambridge efforts. This grant will include six major components:

1. Property owner workshops on lead and new amendments to the Lead Law
2. Development of a lead education curriculum to be used by trained bilingual/bicultural outreach workers, "English as a Second Language" teachers, birthing class instructors, and day care providers (home based and center based) in teaching adults
3. Train-the-Trainer lead education training for the aforementioned groups
4. Development of portable education tools (e.g. demonstration model house, modular display, hardware store point-of-sale displays)
5. Targeted mailings on lead and new amendments to the Lead Law for all Cambridge households and local renovation contractors
6. Development of an Internet page about lead, Lead-Safe Cambridge services, new amendments to the Lead Law, etc.

The Department is very excited about this opportunity to extend its services even further into the community. We believe this grant will be extremely beneficial to Cambridge tenants, property owners, and renovation contractors.
