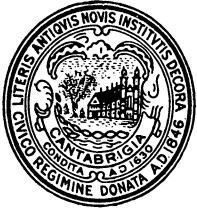

I hereby request an appropriation in the amount of \$217.80 to reimburse Robert W. Kenneally, employee of the Cambridge Police Department, for damages in this amount.

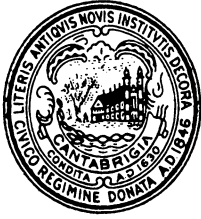


