- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Juanita Temple No. 31 recently conducted a mortgage burning ceremony to celebrate the final payment and completion of the Temple's debt; and
- WHEREAS: Juanita Temple No. 31, through the interest of the late Brother Daniel Ware, was organized under Pocahontas Lodge No. 129 on June 16, 1909 and in only one short year was credited with the establishment of the Phyllis Wheatley Temple in Boston in 1910, as well as several others in Everett, Worcester and as far away as New London, Connecticut; and
- WHEREAS: The Temple has been instrumental over the years in many civic and charitable works and has organized the Past Daughter Ruler's Club in 1937 and the Nurse Unit of the Temple was organized by the late Daughter Sarah Vanderbilt; and
- WHEREAS: Although Juanita Temple No. 31 has no living charter members, the Temple can proudly boast of eleven life-members, thirty-one Past Grand Daughter Rulers, two State Officers and a host of Past State Presidents and Daughter Rulers; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere best wishes and congratulations to Juanita Temple No. 31 in their success and contributions to the community; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Juanita Temple No. 31 on behalf of the entire City Council.
