- WHEREAS: On July 31, 1996 Peg held the position of Emergency Communications Dispatcher in the city's new Emergency Communications Department which combined the police radio room and the fire alarm; and
- WHEREAS: On June 8, 2001 Peg was classified as Joint Dispatch Certification status; and
- WHEREAS: Peg was one of the first Certified Training Officers whose responsibility was to train new Emergency Telecommunication Dispatchers; and
- WHEREAS: From January 9, 2003 through March 1, 2007, Peg held the position of Acting Emergency Communications Supervisor; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record expressing its appreciation to Margaret "Peg" Dwyer for her fifteen years of dedicated service to the citizens and to the City of Cambridge and wish her much happiness in her retirement; and be it further
